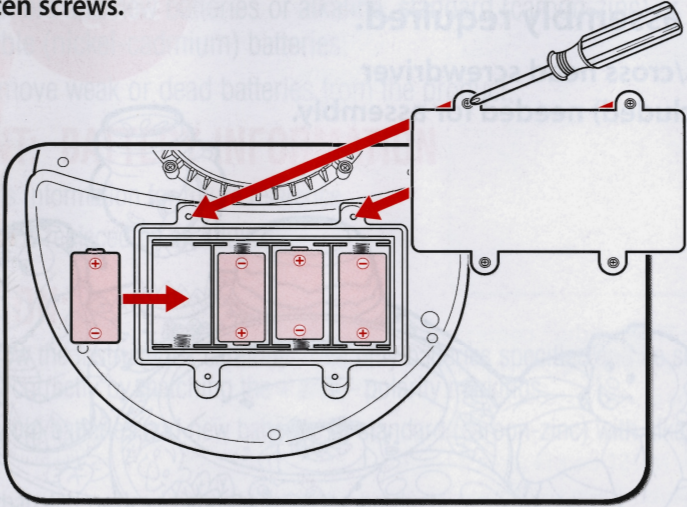

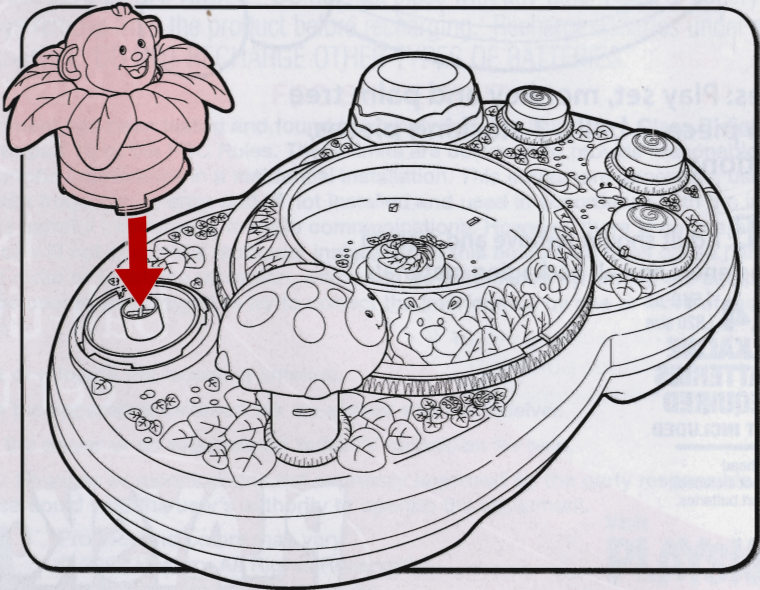
TO INSTALL BATTERIES

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screws in battery compartment door. Screws remain attached to door. Remove door and insert 4 x 1.5V fresh "D" or LR20 size alkaline batteries. Fit door into unit then tighten screws.



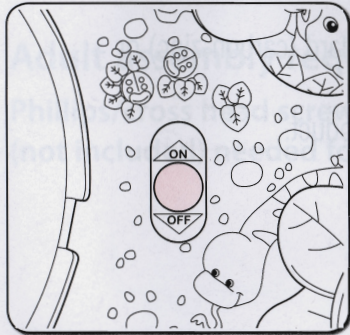
TO ASSEMBLE

1. Snap the monkey and the palm tree piece straight down into the hole. Be sure to align in proper orientation.

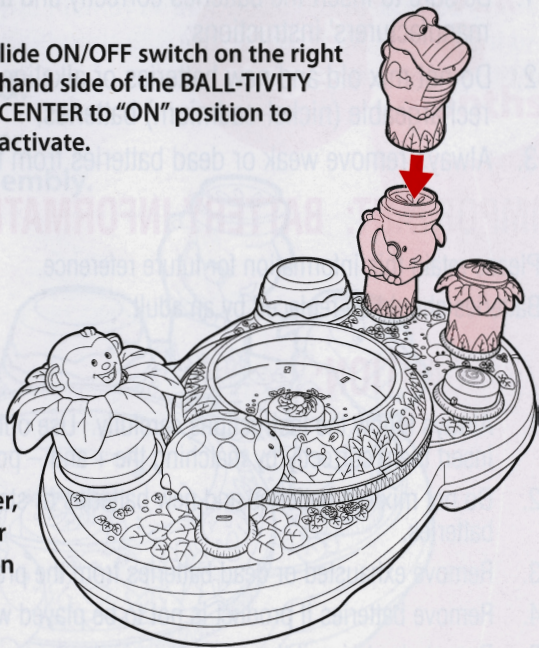


TO PLAY

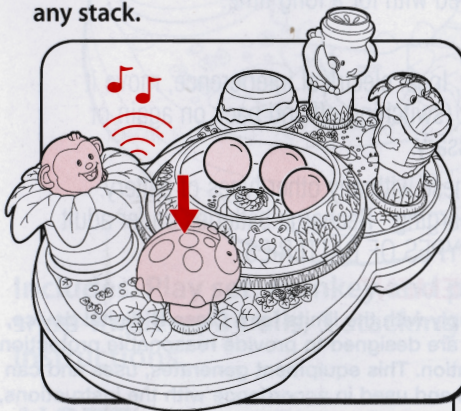
The **BUSY BALL-TIVITY CENTER** toy features air-powered, poppin' droppin' musical fun!



1. Slide ON/OFF switch on the right hand side of the **BALL-TIVITY CENTER** to "ON" position to activate.



NOTE: This product comes with three stackable pieces: palm tree, elephant and alligator. When stacking pieces on top of each other, alligator **MUST** be placed on top for best results. Palm tree spins best on its own port or as the top piece of any stack.



2. Pressing the ladybug causes monkey to pop out of tree and activates air flow as well as music and animal sounds. When music and sounds stop, tap on the ladybug to re-activate them.
3. Swirling ball pool with 3 balls for put 'n take play.

4. Ball floats to top of "volcano".
5. Place the stackable pieces on the three ports to watch them come to life.



NOTE: When storing toy, turn the ON/OFF switch to OFF to prevent accidental activation. If batteries begin to lose power, activities will weaken. For best results, replace batteries when this starts to happen.

CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions;
2. Do not mix old and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries;

CAUTION:

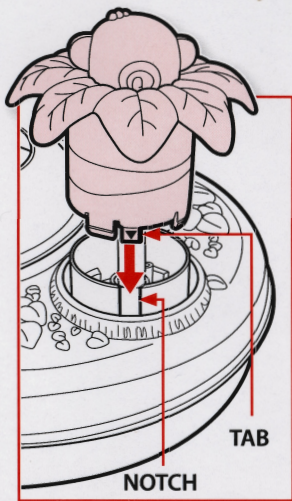

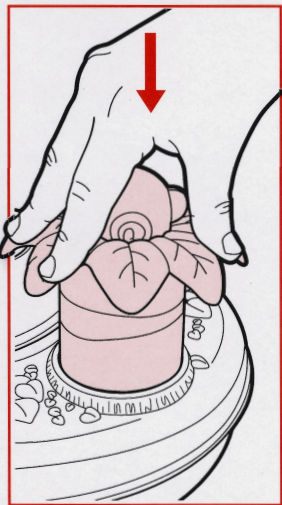

TO ASSEMBLE

Align tab on monkey/palm tree piece with notch in base (see illustration).



Press down on leaves (do not press on monkey's head) until you hear an audible snap. Pull up on monkey/palm tree piece to make sure it is securely snapped in place.
