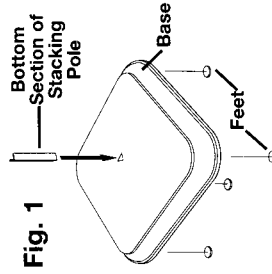
IMPORTANT!

your 3-D Sculpture Puzzle!

GETTING STARTED

ASSEMBLE THE BASE

1. Attach the four rubber feet to the plastic base as shown in Figure 1.



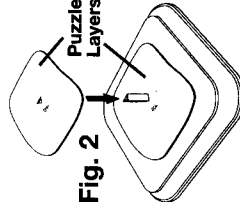
2. Insert the bottom section of the stacking pole into the hole in the base. See Figure 1.
3. Place the other three stacking pole sections aside for now. You will gradually connect them to each other as you assemble the puzzle.

REMOVE AND SORT THE LAYERS

1. Carefully punch out all 162 number-embossed puzzle layers from the cardboard sheets. **IMPORTANT!** The puzzle's "top layer" is not marked with a number. It is, however, called out by name on the cardboard sheet. Place this layer in a safe place for now. Discard all waste.
2. Gently remove and discard the small triangular-shaped piece found in the center of each puzzle layer.
3. Place the puzzle layers number-side up and sort them according to shape and size, **NOT** by number. (Similar sizes and shapes are usually grouped together when stacked.) **IMPORTANT!** Each layer's number is part of a secret numerical sequence revealed only on the sealed solution sheet. See "The Secret Solution" on page 4.

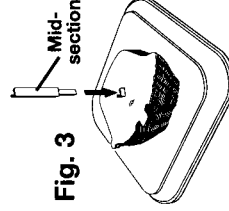
START STACKING!

1. Refer to the photos on the sides of the box bottom to help determine which layer to stack.
2. Slide each layer (number-side up) over the stacking pole as shown in Figure 2.



3. Continue to stack the layers (using their shape and size as a guide) over the stacking pole. **NOTE:** Gently push down on the last layer stacked to close up any gaps that may form during assembly.

4. As you run out of room on the bottom section of the stacking pole, connect either one of the two midsections to the bottom section as shown in Figure 3.
5. Once the first midsection of the stacking pole is full, connect the other midsection as already described.



SECRET SOLUTION INSIDE!

STACKING HINTS

- A layer that belongs stacked on top of another layer will generally follow similar contours and be slightly smaller or larger than the layer stacked before it.
- Nose and ear layers may show some small protruding edges.

THE GRAND FINALE!

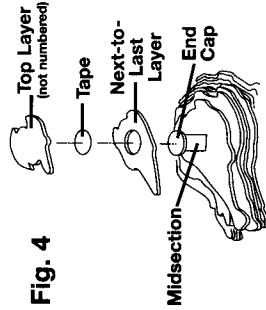

1. Once you have correctly stacked all but the last two layers, insert the end-cap section of the stacking pole as shown in Figure 4.
2. Now place the layer with the center circle (the next-to-last layer) over the end cap.

3. Attach one side of one of the double-stick tape pieces to the top of the end cap. See Figure 4.
4. Now press the puzzle's "top layer" (the unnumbered one) to the last numbered puzzle layer. This completes the puzzle.

CONGRATULATIONS! YOU DID IT!

THE SECRET SOLUTION

If you are absolutely stuck, or simply do not want to solve the puzzle on your own, the enclosed secret solution sheet is just the thing for you. Remove the three perforated edges and open the page. Stack the layers according to the exact numerical sequence detailed inside.

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Below is the numerical stacking sequence needed to correctly assemble King Tut:

STACKING ORDER = LAYER NUMBER

For example, the first layer to be stacked on the base is the layer with the number 107 embossed on it.
