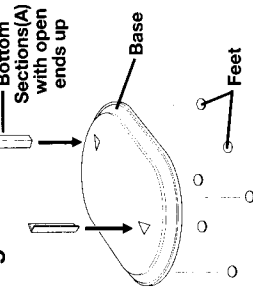
WELCOME TO THE EXCITING WORLD OF 3-D SCULPTURE PUZZLES!

IMPORTANT! Read this instruction sheet in its entirety *before* you begin to assemble your 3-D Sculpture Puzzle!

GETTING STARTED

ASSEMBLE THE BASE

1. Attach six of the rubber feet to the plastic base as shown in Figure 1.
2. Insert the bottom sections of the stacking poles into the holes in the base. See Figure 1.
3. Place the other four stacking pole sections aside for now. You will gradually connect them to each other as you assemble the puzzle.

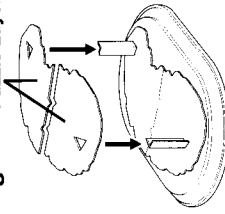
REMOVE AND SORT THE LAYERS

1. Carefully punch out all 182 number-embossed puzzle layers from the cardboard sheets. The puzzle's 4 "top layers" are NOT marked with numbers. They are, however, called out by name on the cardboard sheet. Place these layers in a safe place for now. Discard all waste.
2. Gently remove and discard the small triangular-shaped piece found in the center of each puzzle layer.
3. Place the puzzle layers number-side up and sort them according to shape and size, **NOT** by number. (Similar sizes and shapes are usually grouped together when stacked.) **IMPORTANT!** Each layer's number is part of a secret numerical sequence printed upside-down on the back of this sheet.

START STACKING!

1. Refer to the photos on the sides of the box bottom to help determine which layer to stack.

Fig. 2 Puzzle Layers

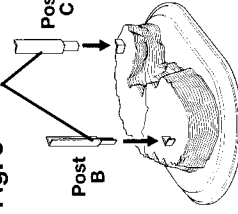


2. Slide each layer (number-side up) over the stacking poles as shown in Figure 2. Complete an entire stacking level (both poles) before stacking additional layers.

3. Continue to stack the layers (using their shape and size as a guide) over the stacking pole(s). NOTE: Gently push down on the last layer stacked to close up any gaps that may form during assembly.

4. As you run out of room on the bottom sections of the stacking poles, connect the midsections to the bottom sections. Be sure to place the stacking poles marked "POST B" and "POST C" as shown in Figure 3.

Fig. 3 Midsections



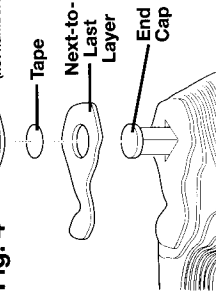
STACKING HINTS

- A layer that belongs stacked on top of another layer will generally follow similar contours and be slightly smaller or larger than the layer stacked before it.
- Nose layers may show some small protruding edges.

THE GRAND FINALE!

1. Once you have correctly stacked all but each pole's last two layers, insert the end-cap section of each stacking pole as shown in Figure 4.

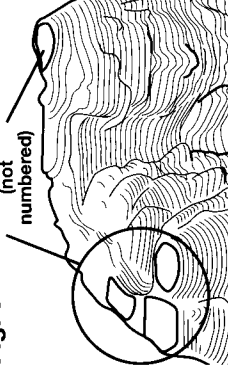


2. Now place the layers with the center circles (the next-to-last layers) over the end caps.
3. Attach one side of one of the double-stick tape pieces to the top of each end cap. See Figure 4.

4. Now press the puzzle's "top layers" (the unnumbered ones) to the last numbered puzzle layers.

5. Refer to Figure 5. Attach the last two blank pieces with double-stick tape as shown. This completes the puzzle.

CONGRATULATIONS! YOU DID IT!

THE SECRET SOLUTION

If you are absolutely stuck, or simply do not want to solve the puzzle on your own, the Secret Solution on the back of this sheet is just the thing for you. Stack the layers according to the exact numerical sequence listed.

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Below is the numerical stacking sequence needed to correctly assemble Mount Rushmore:

STACKING ORDER = PIECE NUMBER(S)

For example, complete the first level by stacking on the base the piece with the number 126 on the left pole, and the piece with the number 171 on the right pole. **IMPORTANT!** Always stack the left pole first, then the right pole. Complete an entire stacking level before stacking additional layers.
