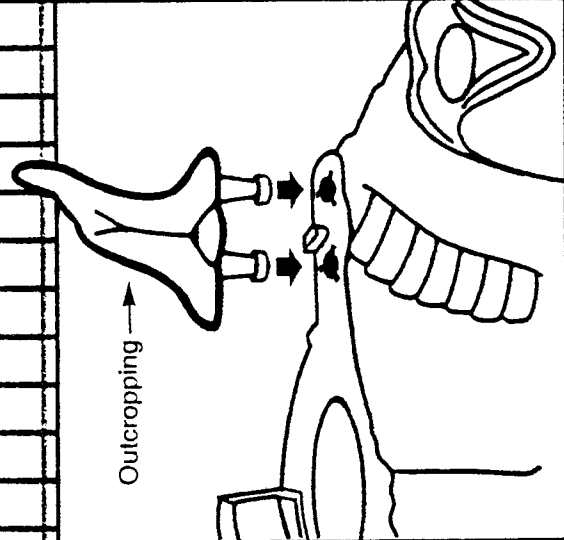


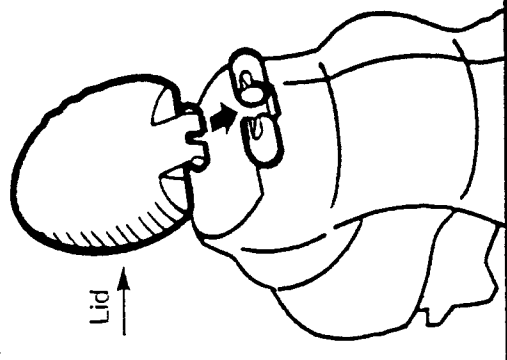

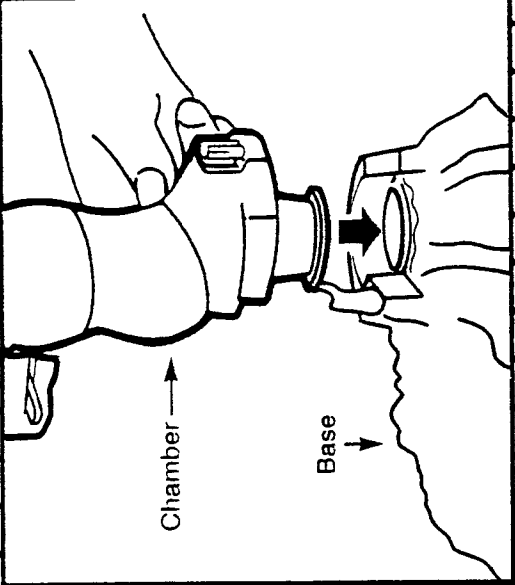
## QUEEN HIVE™ INSTRUCTIONS



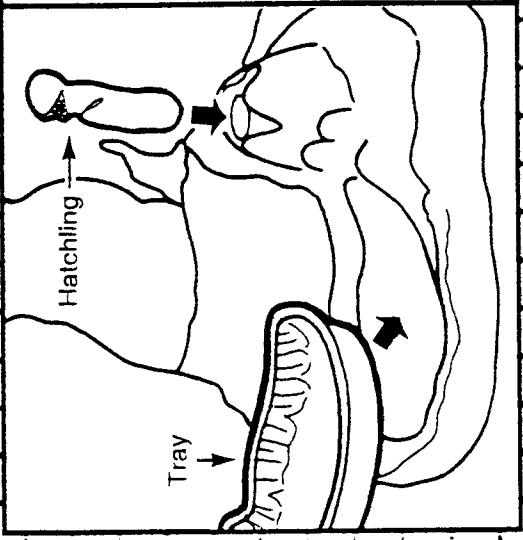
**1.** ONE-TIME ASSEMBLY  
Attach outcropping to base.



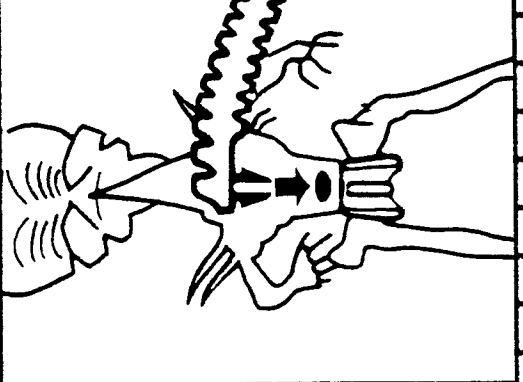
**2.** Snap lid to top of chamber.



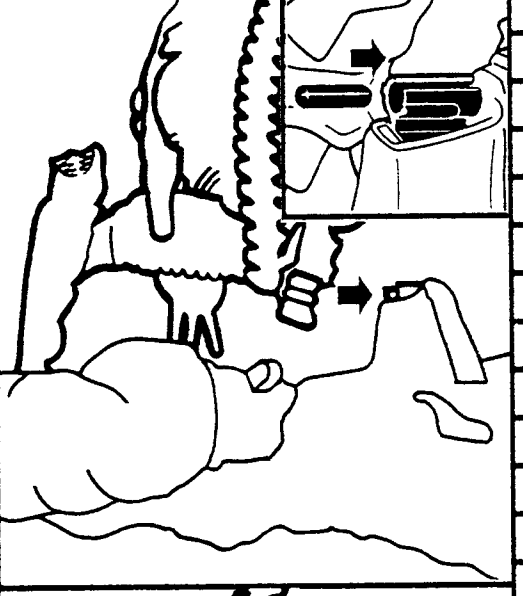
**3.** ONE-TIME ASSEMBLY  
Snap chamber into base.



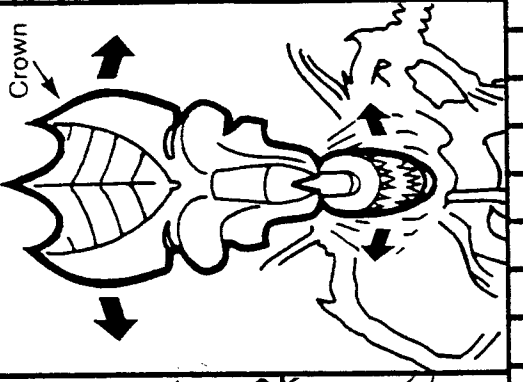
**4.** Place tray into base. Place hatching tray into egg as shown.



**5.** Snap tail onto Queen Alien figure.



**6.** Slide Queen Alien figure into special joint on chamber.

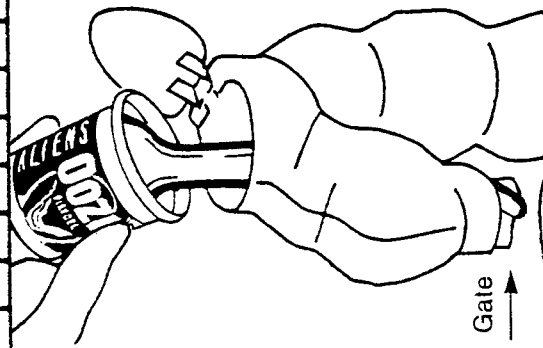


**7.** When the "crown" is moved in one direction, the Queen's jaw moves in the opposite direction.

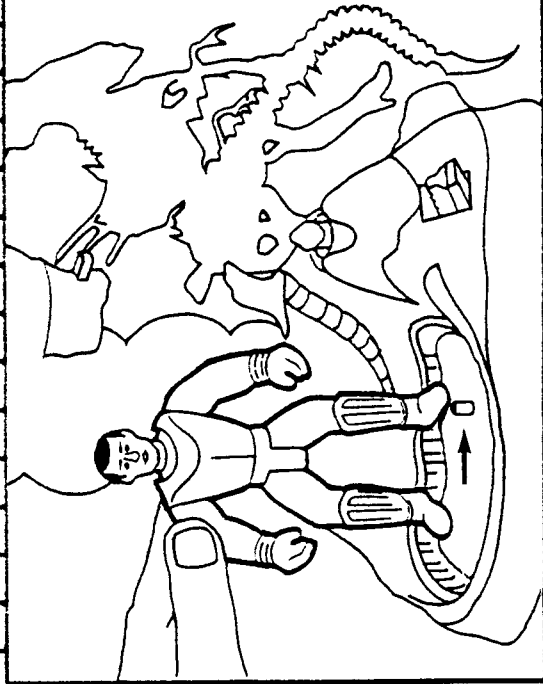

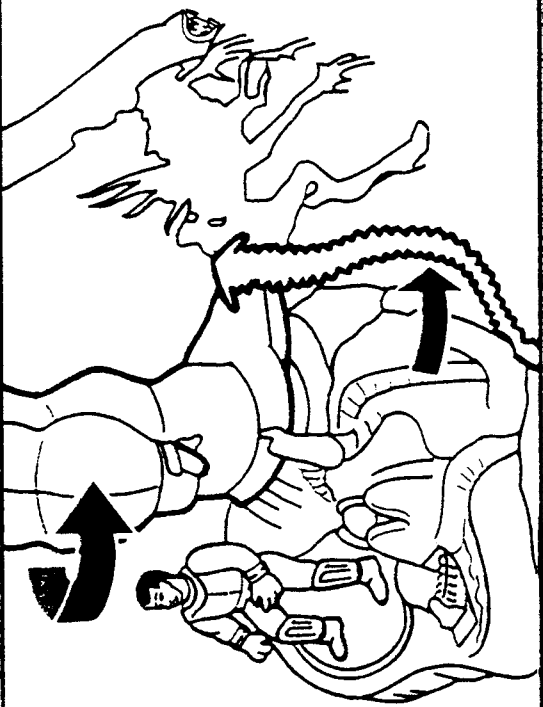

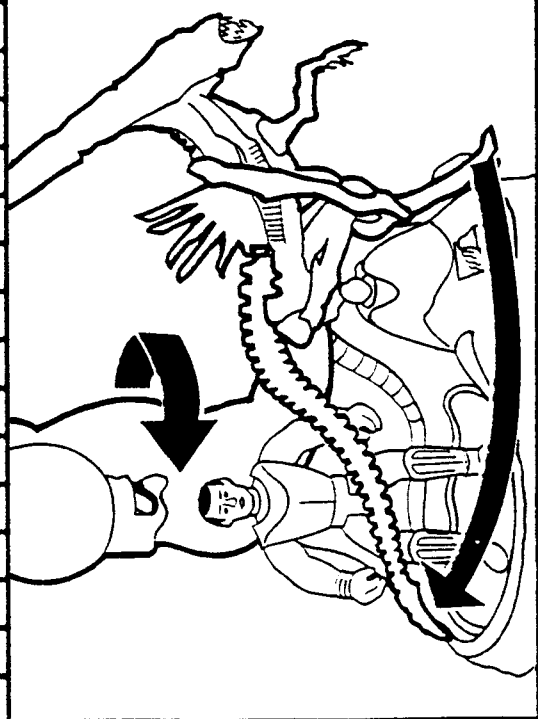
**8.** Close the gate on the chamber. Pour entire can of non-toxic Aliens™ Ooze into the chamber.



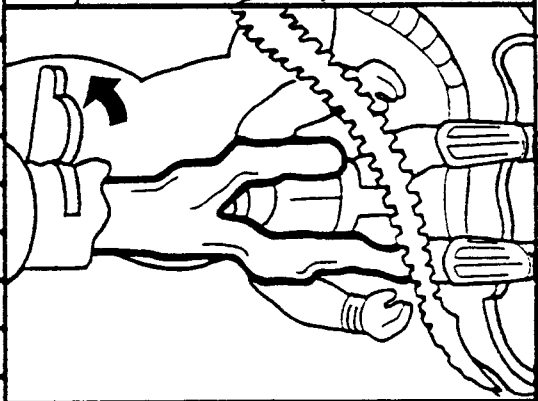
**9.** Place a figure on the foot peg in the tray.



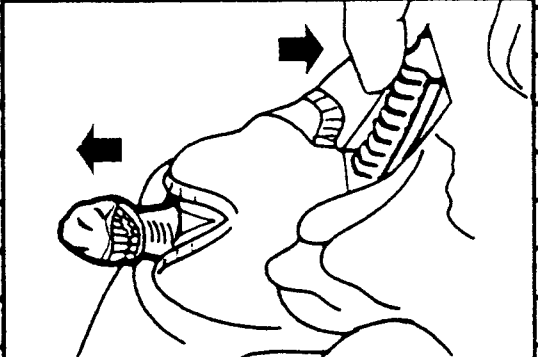
**10.** Rotate chamber in the direction of the arrow, as far as it will go. Position Queen's tail in the direction of the arrow, as far as it will go.



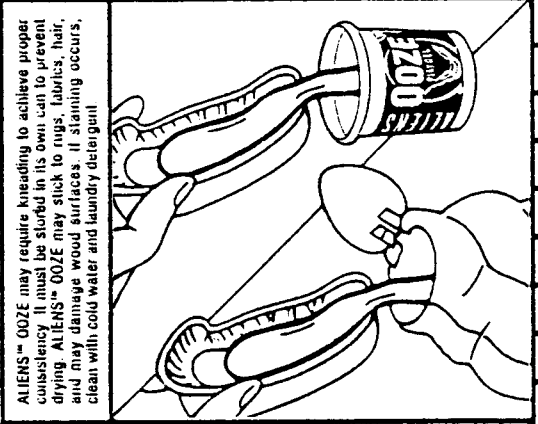
**11.** Now, rotate the chamber in the direction of the arrow as shown; the tail will trap the figure.



**12.** Side gate open to let Aliens™ Ooze fall down onto the captured figure.



**13.** With the hatching in the egg, hit the lever to make it fly out to attack



ALIENS™ OOZE may require kneading to achieve proper consistency. It must be stored in its own can to prevent drying. ALIENS™ OOZE may stick to rugs, fabrics, hair, and may damage wood surfaces. If staining occurs, clean with cold water and laundry detergent.

**14.** To play again, pour the Aliens™ Ooze from the removable tray back into the chamber. For storage, pour only into the can. Make sure the can is tightly sealed.
