Welcome to Cranium Lunch Munch, where the Lunch Lady serves the food and you make the meals!

Object of the Game

Be the first to collect five full meals.

What Makes a Meal?

A full meal is a main dish, vegetable, drink, and dessert of the same color. Rainbow cards are wild and can be played as any color.



Get Ready

1. Place the Squawkbox where everyone can reach it.
2. Shuffle the deck, deal five cards to each player, and put the rest of the cards face down in a draw pile. You can look at your cards, but don't show them to anyone else.
3. The player whose birthday is coming up next goes first.
4. When you're ready, turn on the box.



On Your Turn


1. Make sure you have at least five cards. If you have fewer than five cards in your hand at any time during the game, draw until you have five cards.
2. Press the button. Lunch Lady Lindy asks you to do one of the following:
 - Play One** Play one card. You can either...
 - Start a new meal stack** by taking a card from your hand and placing it face up on the table, next to the draw pile. Up to **four** meal stacks (one for each color) can be on the table at a time. All players add cards to these four meals.
 - OR**
 - Add a card to a meal stack that's already on the table** by playing a different dish of the same color.
 - Whenever you play the fourth card to complete a meal, collect the meal!**
 - If you can't play a card on your turn, draw one card.



How to Win

When you've collected five meals, you're the winner! Hold down the button to start recess!

- Play Two** Play two cards. It's okay if you can play only one card. If you can't play **any** card on your turn, draw one card.
- Chow Down** Play all the cards in your hand that match the dish the Lunch Lady calls out. If she says, "Chow down desserts," play all your playable dessert cards. If you can't play **any** cards, draw one card.
- Draw One** Draw one card.
- Draw Two** Draw two cards.
- Lunch Munch** Get ready! This is a speed round, and everyone plays. The Lunch Lady counts down as all players take turns playing one card at a time as quickly as possible. If you can't play on your turn, pass and draw one card.

If your Squawkbox...

Try this!

Isn't loud enough...

Adjust the volume with the switch on the bottom of the Squawkbox.

Sounds garbled...

Install three new AAA batteries.

Won't turn on...

Install three new AAA batteries.

Stops in the middle of a game...

**Turn your Squawkbox off and then on again.
Install three new AAA batteries.**

CHANGING THE BATTERIES

Your Squawkbox needs three AAA batteries.
Follow these steps to install the batteries.
Batteries must be installed and removed by an adult.

1. Turn over your Squawkbox and unscrew the battery cover.
2. Insert the batteries as indicated.
3. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw.

BATTERY SAFETY

- Do not put the batteries in backwards. Positive (+) and negative (-) ends must be inserted in the correct directions following the polarity (+/-) diagram in the battery compartment.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries must be removed before recharging.
- Rechargeable batteries must be recharged by an adult only.
- Batteries must be installed and removed by an adult only.
- Remove exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
- Do not try to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
