

FEEDING TIME

NOTE: Be sure to use only plain water or water mixed with doll juice mix with your baby doll. Do not use Baby Alive* Doll Food (sold separately); it is not intended for use with this doll.

Before you feed your doll, make sure she's wearing a diaper that's securely fastened.

- 1. Fill sippy cup with cold, clean water and a packet of BABY ALIVE doll juice mix.
- 2. Tighten the sippy cup top securely.
- 3. Hold your doll in a reclining position. Make sure her head is higher than her tummy.
- 4. Place the sippy cup in the doll's mouth, and give the sippy cup small, gentle squeezes. The doll will raise her arms and make sucking sounds.
- 5. After you take the sippy cup out of the doll's mouth, she will either say that she is "all done" or ask for more. If you want your doll to fall asleep, keep the sippy cup in her mouth until she yawns and closes her eyes.

Do not feed doll more than one sippy cup of doll juice mix or water before changing her diaper. Feeding the doll less than one sippy cup is okay.

Do not use real juice or other beverages besides cold, clean water.

STAIN ADVISEMENT: BABY ALIVE® Doll Juice Mix may stain some surfaces. Adult supervision recommended. If spilled, wash with soap and water.



After feeding your doll, you'll need to change her diaper!



To change diaper:

- 1. Remove diaper and wipe doll clean with a soft, damp cloth or paper towel.
- 2. If you have fed the doll using doll juice, follow cleaning instructions.
- 3. Put on a new diaper and fasten securely.
 - ALWAYS change your doll's diaper and clean her after she drinks.
 - NEVER let your doll sit with a wet diaper.
 - Discard wet diapers; they cannot be washed or reused.

TO CLEAN

If using BABY ALIVE® Doll Juice Mix, it is important to rinse doll with cold, clean water immediately after each use. If any doll juice mix remains in the doll, it can become difficult to clean.

- To clean doll after feeding her doll juice mix, give her a sippy cup full of cold, clean
 water until any remaining juice mix has been rinsed away and the water runs clear (it's
 best to do this over a sink). Use a soft, damp cloth or paper towel to wipe away any
 juice mix on doll's mouth. Allow doll to dry.
- Clean doll's face and body by wiping gently with a soft, damp cloth.
 Do not rub.
- Do not submerge doll in water; it is not intended for bath-time play.
- Do not place any foreign objects in doll's mouth or any other opening.
- Doll's clothes are machine-washable (mild detergent, cold water, gentle cycle, no bleach); they can also be spot-cleaned with a cool damp cloth; hang to dry.
- · Hand-wash sippy cup with mild dish soap and water; it is not dishwasher-safe.




TROUBLESHOOTING

- If the doll is unresponsive, or if movement and sounds become erratic, the battery power may be low. Replace batteries.
- If your doll is unresponsive and the doll's arms seem to be in the wrong position, manually adjust arms until they both click into place.

TO REPLACE BATTERIES .

Replace demo batteries with alkaline batteries. Use a Phillips screwdriver (not included) to loosen screw in battery compartment cover (screw remains attached to cover). Remove cover. Remove and discard demo batteries. Replace with 4 x 1.5V AA alkaline batteries. Replace cover and tighten screw.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION ACAUTION:

1. TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- a. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.
- b. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- c. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- d. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- e. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- f. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.
- 2. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
