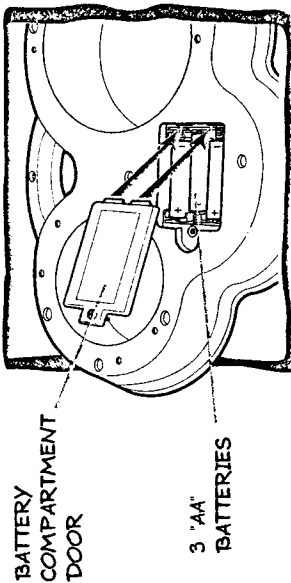


AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF FEATURE

The toy automatically shuts off if it is not activated within a short period of time.

TO INSTALL NEW BATTERIES

NOTE: Do not press the musical note buttons when inserting batteries. If Song Magic Bongos does not respond when you tap on the drum surface(s), leave the toy alone for approx 25 seconds (this allows the toy to shut off by itself). Then, press the musical note button to start the playing.



1. With Phillips screwdriver, loosen screw in battery compartment door. Remove door (screw remains attached to door).
2. Discard old batteries. Insert 3 fresh "AA" alkaline batteries into compartment as shown. Replace door and tighten screw.

CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions;
2. Do not mix old and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries;
3. Always remove weak or dead batteries from the product.

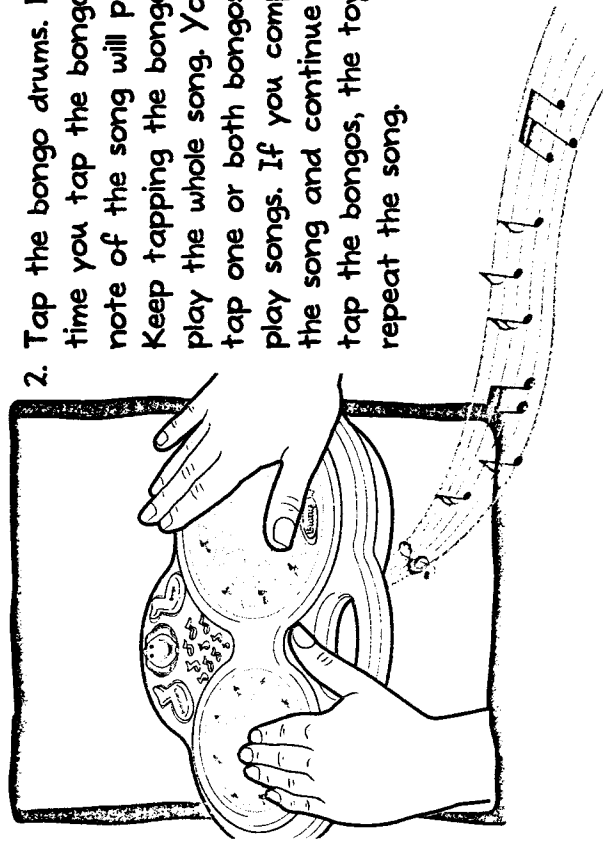


TO PLAY WITH SONG MAGIC™ BONGOS

1. To activate toy, press either musical note button. The toy will play part of a song you know it is activated.



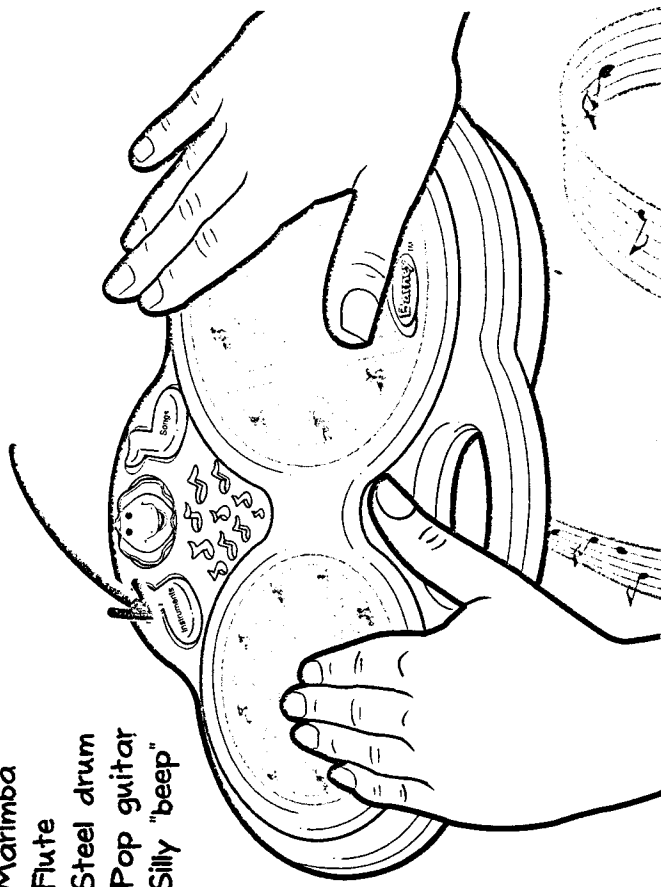
2. Tap the bongo drums. Each time you tap the bongos, one note of the song will play. Keep tapping the bongos to play the whole song. You can tap one or both bongos to play songs. If you complete the song and continue to tap the bongos, the toy will repeat the song.



3. You can play each song in 5 different instrument sounds. To change sounds, press the **INSTRUMENT** musical note button. You can change instrument sounds at any time. Each time you press the button, a single note of that instrument will play.

The instrument sounds are:

- Marimba
- Flute
- Steel drum
- Pop guitar
- Silly "beep"



4. To change songs, press the **SONG** musical note button. You can change songs at any time. Each time you press the button, part of the song will play.

The songs are:
