


MESSAGE TO PARENTS

Thank you for bringing home BOB'S COUNTING HAMMER. This is a wonderful educational product for your child. It's exciting to learn with Bohl

Bob will help your child to learn how to count to twenty forward and backward! Your child will also sharpen his/her abilities to listen and concentrate. These fundamental skills combine to form the building blocks for future development.

Please read the instructions carefully and learn about the different features of BOB'S COUNTING HAMMÉR. This will allow you to explain them to your child in a way that is easy for them to understand.



ON/OFF

- Locate the switch on the top of the hammer. Press this button to turn ON/OFF Bob's COUNTING HAMMER.

FORWARD / BACKWARD MODE SWITCH

- Locate the switch beside ON/OFF switch. Move to switch from FORWARD counting mode that counts from one to twenty, to BACKWARD counting mode that counts from twenty to one.

INSERTING THE BATTERIES


Important Note: Battery installation should be done by an adult.

- 1. "BOB'S COUNTING HAMMER" requires 3 x 1.5V "AAA" or LRO3" batteries.
- 2. To replace the batteries in the COLINTING HAMMER, locate the battery compartment on the handle of the hammer
- 3. Open the battery compartment door by using a standard Phillips head screwdriver to turn the screw counterclockwise (ILLUSTRATION 1).
- 4. Remove discharged batteries (if necessary) and insert new batteries according to the diagram provided in the battery compartment (ILLUSTRATION 2).
- 5. Close the battery compartment door and dispose of used batteries properly.

Note: These instructions are also stamped onto the back of the product for future reference.

WHEN TO REPLACE BATTERIES

Change the batteries when Bob's voice becomes garbled or seems to be slowing down during play, or when pressing a button does not trigger a response from the unit.

- Do not mix old and new batteries
- Do not mix alkaline, standard or rechargeable batteries
- Battery installation should be done by an adult.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.



- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision (if removable).
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.

Do not throw or kick the product, and do not push sharp objects through the speaker openings.

HOW TO PLAY

"BOB'S COUNTING HAMMER" combines the fun of a play tool and learning to count with the friendly world of BOB THE BUILDER to encourage learning of numbers. Your child's ability to concentrate and listen will also be enhanced!

Press the ON button to begin the game.

You'll hear Bob say, "HELLO, CAN WE BUILD IT? YES, WE CAN!"

Use MODE SWITCH to pick FORWARD or BACKWARD counting.

PLEASE NOTE: The end of the COUNTING HAMMER is hard plastic. Please supervise your child when playing with the COUNTING HAMMER, as with any toy. Please direct them as to the best places to play.

TURNING THE UNIT DFF

"BOB'S COUNTING HAMMER" has an automatic shut-off feature to help prolong battery life. If there is still no activity, the "BOB'S COUNTING HAMMER" will then automatically turn itself off. You'll hear Bob say, "GOODBYE!" just before the game shuts itself off. Press the "ON" button to restart the toy.
