

How to Play

Just like on the TV show, the rules are simple and the DVD takes you through, step by step.

First, go to the DVD and select how many people or teams are playing, 1 or 2.

On each board, you'll see 10 subjects, with questions ranging from 6 year old to 10 year old.

Choose a category and select your answer. If you're not sure, you can Peek and Copy from one of my class just once per game before you answer.

Get the question right to win £250, and keep answering to win more money each time.

£5,000 is the magic number! Once you've got to this point, you keep this amount, even if you drop out or get a question wrong. Answer 10 questions correctly and you'll win £100,000. If you can then answer the final Age 10 question, you could win the game and £250,000!

Peek and Copy

Once each per game, you can Peek or Copy a classmate's answer before you lock in your final answer.

Peek: Select **PEEK** on the DVD. Choose one of my class to help you. Look at the answer they've given, then go back to your answer screen and lock in your final answer.

You don't *have to* go with your classmate's answer if you think you know better!

Copy: Select **COPY** on the DVD. Choose one of my class to help you and look at the answer they've given. This time, you have to take their answer, whether you think it's right or not. That's what happens when you copy someone else's work!

Save

If you've used up your Peek and Copy options, you can be Saved after giving a wrong answer. Select **SAVE** after getting an answer wrong and choose a classmate to help you. If the classmate you choose has the right answer, phew! – you're still in the game.

TIP: Don't use your Save until you've used up your Peek and Copy options.

If the classmate's answer is wrong too, it's Game Over for you – you must make your confession to the other players:

"I am NOT smarter than a 10 year old!"

Drop Out

If, at any point, you think a question is too hard for you to answer, you can take the money and run.

You're Out!

If you've used your Peek, your Copy and your Save and you get an answer wrong, or if you drop out of the game, you're out and the next player takes their turn. Before they do, you must make your embarrassing confession to the other players. Stand up and announce to everyone in the room:

"I am NOT smarter than a 10 year old!"

If you're playing on your own, make your confession to the next five people you see!
