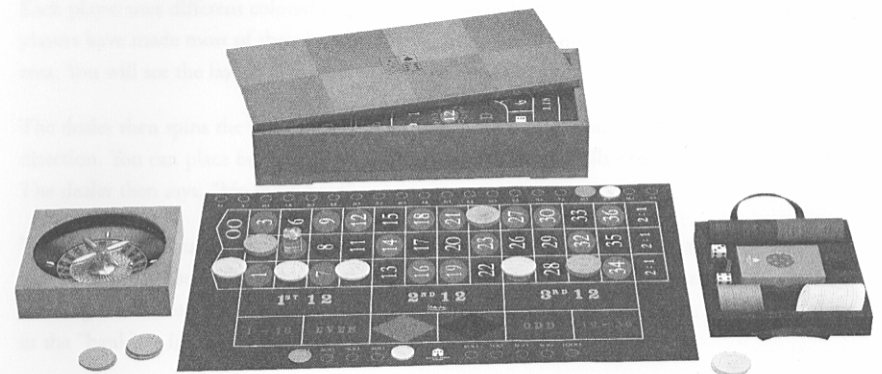

Roulette

You'll Need: Roulette Playing Felt, Roulette Wheel, 1 Roulette Ball, Betting Chips, Scoring Markers, Dealer Marker

Roulette is played on a table using a betting area and a roulette wheel. The wheel consists of 38 compartments: there are 36 red and black compartments numbered 1 to 36, and two compartments numbered 0 and 00.

Before you can place your bet you have to get special roulette betting chips from the dealer. Each player uses different colored chips for easier identification. The game starts after the players have made most of their bets by placing them on the numbered layout of the betting area. You will see the layout explained on the next page.

The dealer then spins the wheel in one direction and the small roulette ball in the opposite direction. You can place bets until the ball leaves the track and falls onto the spinning wheel. The dealer then says, "No more bets!"

The ball will eventually fall into one of the wheel's numbered compartments; this determines the winning number. When the wheel stops, the dealer (using the dealer marker) will mark the winning number on the betting area. The dealer then removes all losing bets, placing the chips in the "bank" in front of him/her, and pays out the winning bets accordingly.

SETTING THE TABLE

- Place the roulette playing felt on the table between the players.
- Choose a dealer and place the roulette wheel with ball near that player. The dealer is in charge of spinning the roulette wheel. He/she is also responsible for clearing any losses from the table and placing them in the bank as well as paying out any winning bets on the table.
- Each player takes 25 of the same colored betting chips and the 2 smaller matching colored scoring markers.
- Place one scoring marker for each player (matching color) on the scoring track: one goes on the 25 and the other goes near the 100.
