## **EVERYBODY, LET'S SING!**


Song lyrics are included so you and baby can sing along with the music! It's a fun way to introduce your baby to music and teach first words in a tuneful way.

## GOTTA HAND IT TO YOU!



#### TO REPLACE BATTERIES:

Your child can create songs right away because the batteries are already in the toy! When Create-A-Song slows down, replace the exhausted batteries as follows:

- 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver, loosen screw in battery compartment door on bottom of toy. (Screw will remain attached to door.) Remove door.
- 2. Remove exhausted batteries. Insert 4 fresh "AA" batteries as shown. Insert tabs on end of door into slots in compartment opening, and lower door into place. Tighten screw.

  Create-A-Song is now ready for your little songsmith again!

## **CAUTION:** TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- 1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions.
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries.
- 3. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- 4. Always remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.



#### Musical Instrument Buttons:

- To begin a song, press the guitar, piano or drum button. Each time your child presses one of the buttons, the toy plays a few notes of the song. Continue to press any of these buttons to play the rest of the song. Press one button or press different combinations of the 3 buttons, to create fun variations of the song.
- When the song is finished, press one of the 3 buttons and the next song will start. Create-A-Song plays 7 different songs in all.


#### Song Bar:


- Press the song bar and Create-A-Song plays the entire song with a full band sound!
- If your child presses the song bar before finishing a song with the musical instrument buttons, the toy will play the song in its entirety. If your child presses the song bar while it is playing a song, the toy starts playing the next song.
- If your child presses a musical instrument button while the song bar is playing a song, the toy plays a few notes of the song being played by the song bar. Your child can continue creating the song with the buttons.

## Note to Parent:

If Playskool® Create-A-Song<sup>TM</sup> stops working, remove the batteries from the toy, then insert the <u>same</u> batteries back into the toy. If the toy still does not work, replace the batteries with fresh, new batteries.
