X3BATTERIES INCLUDED

Replace with 3 x 1.5V "AAA" or LR03 size alkaline batteries. Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) needed to replace batteries.

Note to consumer: This toy is packaged in "TRY ME" mode. When you bring the toy home, activate its full range of features by moving the toy's TRY ME/OFF/ON switch to the "ON" position.

Getting to Know Your Pet



Mouth sensor

When you press down on your toy bird's tongue (by "feeding" it, for example), it will chirp, flap its wings and make eating sounds!

TRY ME/OFF/ON

Switch and battery door on tummy.

A sensor is a part of the toy that responds to your touch!

How to Play



To activate your toy bird, slide the TRY ME/OFF/ON switch on bird's belly to the ON position. Your bird is now ready to play.

Play Mode

Just like a real baby bird, your toy baby bird is "hungry" a lot! "Feed" it and it will make happy eating sounds. The more you "feed" your toy bird, the happier it will be!

Your toy bird also responds to being "fed" (or when you press its tongue) by chirping, flapping its wings, and moving its head and beak.

Sleep Mode

If you stop playing with your toy bird for about a minute, it will go to "sleep." You can "wake" it up again by "feeding" it or pressing its tongue down.

NOTE: This toy uses battery power whenever its switch is in the "ON" position. When you're not playing with the toy, move its switch to the "OFF" position to help conserve battery life.

Troubleshooting



If your pet doesn't seem to respond properly, first try sliding the TRY ME/OFF/ON switch to OFF, then back to ON. If that doesn't work, you may need to replace the batteries.

CLEANING & CARE

To clean your pet, gently brush its fur with a cloth or soft brush to loosen any dirt. Then use a slightly damp cloth to remove stains.

- · Do not put in washing machine.
- Do not submerge in water.
- Do not use detergent or stain removers on fur.
- Do not get wet; to remove stains, use only a slightly damp cloth on the fur.
- To prevent staining fur, wipe off dirt immediately.
- If toy gets wet, remove batteries and dry fur; once fur is completely dry, replace batteries.
- · Avoid spilling food or beverages on toy.
- Do not throw or kick toy, and do not push sharp objects through speaker openings
- Do not leave toy in direct sunlight: high temperatures will destroy the mechanism.

To Replace Batteries

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screw in battery compartment door on bird's tummy (screw remains attached to door). Remove and discard old batteries. Replace with fresh 3 x 1.5V "AAA" or LR03 size alkaline batteries. Replace door and tighten screw.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION



 As with all small batteries, the batteries used with this toy should be kept away from small children who still put things in their mouths. If they are swallowed, promptly see a doctor and have the doctor phone (202) 625-3333 collect. If you reside outside the United States, have the doctor call your local poison control center.
