## SETUP:

1. Open the gameboard on a flat surface.
2. Remove the Dora pawn from the cardboard parts sheet and fit it into the pawn stand.
3. Punch out the 26 tiles from the parts sheet. Discard the cardboard waste.
4. Place the tiles so that the pictures are face up and the letters are facedown. Mix up the tiles then place them so that they are all facing the same way.



## GAMEPLAY:

The youngest player starts.  
Play then continues in a clockwise direction.

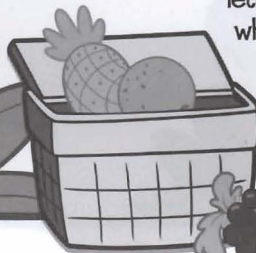
1. Place the Dora pawn on the "Let's Go/Vámonos!" space on the gameboard.  
NOTE: As the players take their turns, the pawn will be moved along the path from letter to letter through the alphabet to finish at Dora's picnic after the "Z" letter block.

2. On your turn, move Dora to the next letter space. Now look at the tiles and try to find the one with the picture of an item that starts with that letter. When you think you have found it, turn it over.

- If the letter on the tile back matches the letter you are looking for, you can keep the tile. This ends your turn.

- If the letter on the tile back doesn't match the letter you are looking for, place it back down, picture-side up. This ends your turn. The next player now tries to find the correct picture tile. HINT: Try to remember the letter on the tile so that when Dora gets to that letter you will remember where to find it.

NOTE: As an extra help, notice that the color of the tile will match the color of the letter block on the gameboard.

When the Dora pawn has been moved through the complete alphabet, from the "A" letter block to the "Z" letter block, and reaches the picnic, players each create a stack with their tiles. The player with the tallest stack wins the game.
