PROJECTS TO DO

ADULT SUPERVISION SUGGESTED

HOT pans and items. Handle carefully. Unit Interior, Top and Back-Do not touch.

Warning: Shock Hazard. Pull plug out of receptacle before removing back and changing light bulb. Do not use candelabra bulbs larger than 60 watts.

Always: Unplug unit when not in use; use pan handler to move pans through heat chamber; allow items to cool before handling.

Never use plugged-in unit around water at any time; never leave plugged-in unit unattended or unassembled; never push pan through unit with your fingers; do not leave empty pan or pan handler in unit.

Danger: To prevent electric shock, do not immerse unit in water. Wipe clean with damp cloth. We recommend that you periodically examine the toy for potential hazards and that any potentially hazardous parts be repaired or replaced.

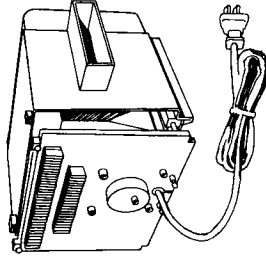
Do Not use candelabra bulbs of higher wattage.
120 Volts A.C. only-60Hz 60 watts.

Caution: Adult supervision required. Internal metal edges. Care should be taken during installation of the light bulb. Phillips screwdriver and scissors required. Covering your work surface is recommended since paint and cooking oil may be used.



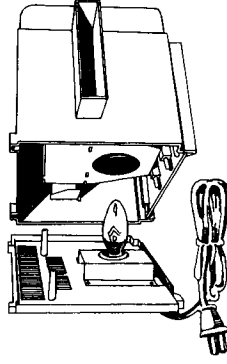
LET'S GET READY

Remove Back of Unit
▶ Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove the four (4) screws from the back panel and lift panel out.



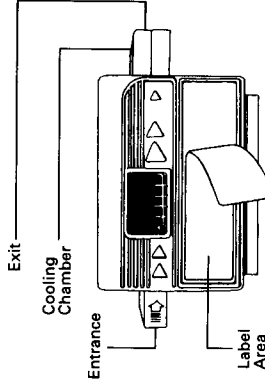
Install Light Bulb

- ▶ Install one 60 watt candelabra bulb into socket in panel. Do not overtighten bulb.
- ▶ Do not use bulbs of higher wattage.
- ▶ Replace back panel and four screws.

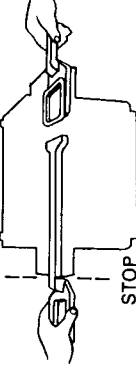

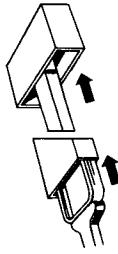
- ▶ Apply label to front of unit as shown.



HOW TO USE YOUR EZ-2-DO FASHION MACHINE



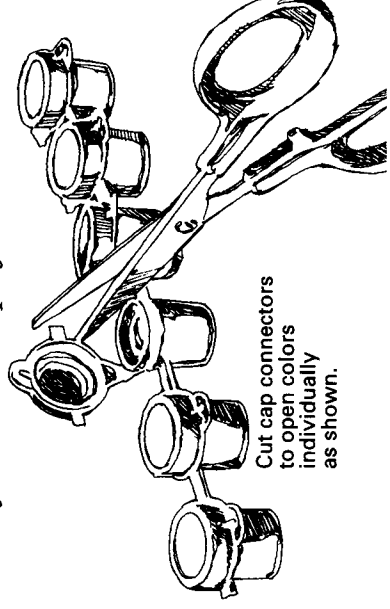
- ▶ Push pan with item into the cooling chamber with push bar side of pan holder. Push all the way up to the "stop" on the pan holder.
- ▶ In the instructions you will see this symbol... **Cool** **sec**. It indicates how long you should allow an item to cool.



- ▶ Using the push bar side of the pan holder, slide pan into heating chamber until line on side of handle lines up with edge of chute.
- ▶ **Do not place mold in heating unit.** In the instructions you will see this symbol... **Heat** **min**. It indicates how long you should allow an item to heat.

GOOD WORKING HABITS

1. *Get permission to work before you begin.*
2. *Most of the extra supplies you'll need can be found around the house.*
3. *Wear a smock or big, old shirt to protect your clothes. Cover your workspace too.*
4. *Follow the directions carefully for each project.*
5. *Don't put art materials in your mouth or let a younger child do it either.*
6. *You will want a few paper plates on which to mix paint. Plastic margarine tubs are great for rinse water.*
7. *You must wait to let something cool or dry before going on to the next step. This is very important.*
8. *Finish by cleaning your workspace. Your tools, including the brush, should be cleaned in warm, soapy water.*
9. *Save these instructions for each time you start a new project.*



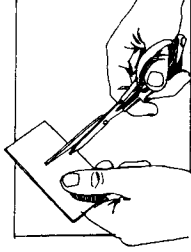
Cut cap connectors to open colors individually as shown.

1 EZ EARRINGS/ BARRETTES

Preheat unit 15 minutes

U=Need From Set: ■ Plastic ■ Adhesive foam tape ■ Mold ■ Pan

U=Need From Home: ■ Non-stick spray cooking oil ■ Scissors

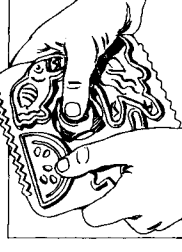


1A. Cut plastic in half (2 squares or 2 thin strips).

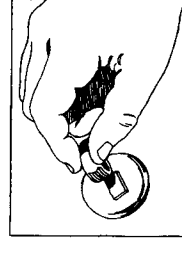


1B. Lightly coat pan with cooking oil and place one plastic strip in pan, shiny side up.

Heat 2 min. - Cool 1 min.
Remove pan with holder. Use knife to gently lift plastic from pan.



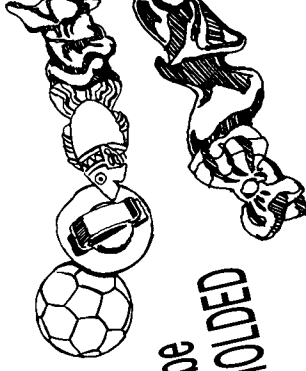
1C. Press warm soft plastic into mold shiny side down (you can leave the extra plastic outside mold as part of the design or fold behind molded shape). Let cool.



1D. Remove plastic and wipe off excess oil or wash with soap and dry. Attach earrings or barrettes with small piece of adhesive foam tape. Wear it with style!

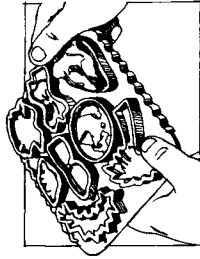

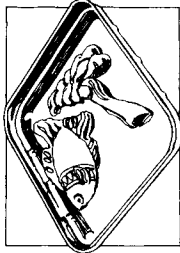
2 MOLDED BEADS & NECKLACES

Preheat unit 15 minutes

U•Need From Set: ■ Clay ■ Paint ■ Cord ■ Pan
 ■ Bead rod ■ Brush ■ Knife ■ Mold



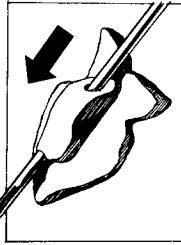
2A. Soften clay in hands. Dip into cool water then press wet clay into mold. [Do not place mold in heating unit.]



2B. Spread excess clay to edges of mold to help remove shape. Trim excess clay from shape with knife, place in pan, design side up.

Heat 10 min. - Cool 2 min.

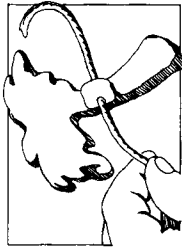
Remove pan with holder.



2C. Place small amount of clay on back of shapes and place bead rod in position to make a hole. Roll a round or shaped bead and place on bead rod.

Heat 10 min. - Cool 2 min.

Remove bead rod.



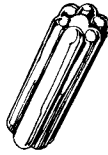
2E. String on cord. Wear it with style!

EZ BEAD DESIGN TECHNIQUES

1. Combination Colors

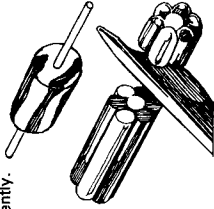
Soften clay with hands and mix colors of clay to get new colors. Different combinations create new colors:

Yellow + Blue = Green
 Blue + Pink = Purple
 Pink + Yellow = Orange



3. Dots

Roll a thin coil of one color about 1/4" thick. Then roll several coils of different colors. Lay alternating colors side by side to form a bundle. Press together gently.



Slice into sections. Roll each section into a ball to get a marbled look. Pierce with bead rod. Always heat beads with bead rod in place.

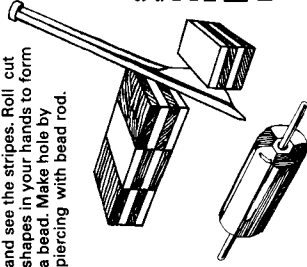
Heat 10 min. - Cool 2 min.

2. Stripes

Roll clay in your hands until you get the desired color. Flatten different colors of clay and lay them on top of each other. Press together when all layers are complete. Cut shapes and see the stripes. Roll cut shapes in your hands to form a bead. Make hole by piercing with bead rod.



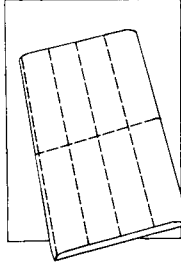
BEAD IT!

3 SPIRAL PLASTIC BEADS

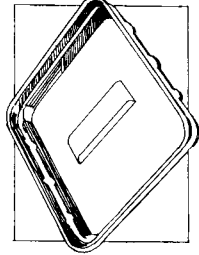
Preheat unit 15 minutes

U•Need From Set: ■ Plastic ■ Bead Rod ■ Pan

U•Need From Home: ■ Non-stick spray cooking oil ■ Scissors



3A. Cut plastic strip in half, then cut each half into 4 or 5 long strips.



3B. Place one strip, shiny side up, in a lightly oiled pan, or place colored strips touching each other, to melt into rainbow strips.

Heat 2 min. - Cool 1 min.



3C. Wrap warm, softened plastic strips around bead rod to form spiral shape.

Cool 15 seconds

Remove from bead rod.



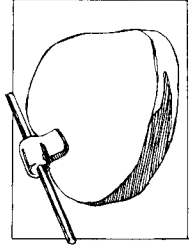
3E. String beads on cord by themselves or with other beads to create a bracelet or necklace. You may also attach spirals to other softened plastic pieces to create additional jewelry. Wear it with style!

4 SWEETHEART PENDANT

Preheat unit 15 minutes

U•Need From Set: ■ Clay ■ Paint ■ Plastic ■ Cord ■ Pan ■ Bead Rod ■ Knife ■ Brush ■ Mold

U•Need From Home: ■ Non-stick spray cooking oil ■ Scissors



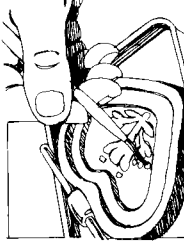
4A. Soften clay in hands. Dip into cool water then press wet clay into mold. Spread clay to edges of mold to help remove shape. Trim excess clay with knife. Attach clay piece at top and pierce with bead rod as shown.



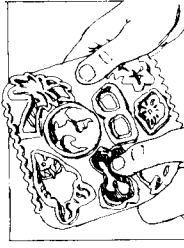
4B. Place molded heart, design side up, in pan with bead rod still in position.

Heat 15 min. - Cool 2 min.

Remove bead rod.



4C. Paint clay shapes and let dry.



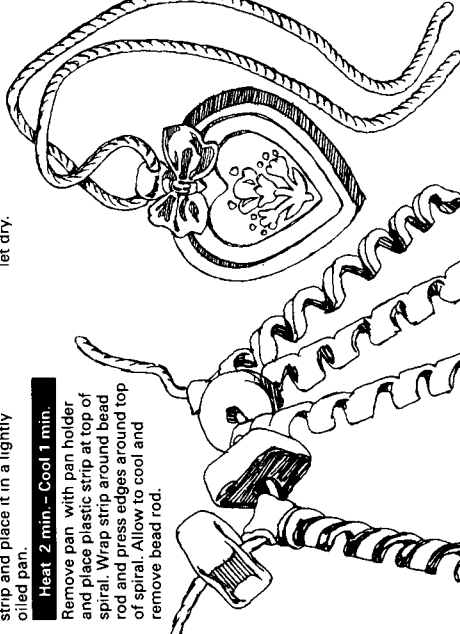
4D. Cut a piece of plastic in half. Place one half in lightly oiled pan shiny side up.

Heat 2 min. - Cool 1 min.

Remove pan with holder. Press all warm, soft plastic into bow mold shiny side down - Let cool.



4E. Attach bow on top of clay heart with adhesive foam tape. String cord through top. Wear it with style!

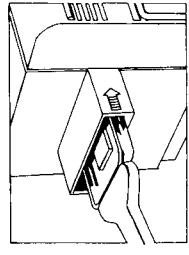


5 EZ RINGS

Preheat unit 15 minutes

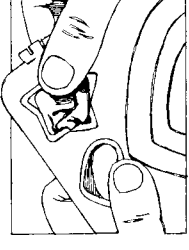
U•Need From Set: ■ Plastic ■ Adhesive foam tape ■ Mold ■ Pan

U•Need From Home: ■ Non-stick spray cooking oil ■ Scissors



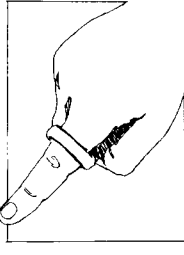
5A. Cut one piece of plastic into 4 pieces with scissors. Lightly oil pan. Place one piece at a time in pan shiny side up.

Heat 2 min. - Cool 1 min.

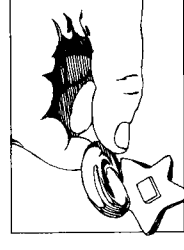


5B. Remove pan with holder. Press warm plastic into mold shiny side down - Push all plastic into mold behind design. Set aside. Heat another piece of plastic.

Heat 2 min. - Cool 1 min.



5C. Stretch and roll the warm plastic around your finger or something round to make a ring. Make sure you can get it over your knuckle. Let cool in position.



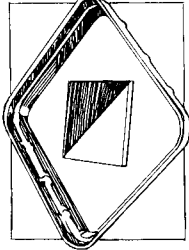
5D. Attach shape to ring with adhesive foam tape. Wear it with style!

6 EZ BLENDED JEWELRY

Preheat unit 15 minutes

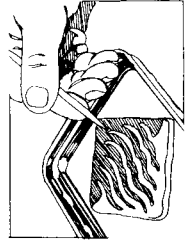
U•Need From Set: ■ Plastic ■ Adhesive foam tape ■ Pan

U•Need From Home: ■ Non-stick spray cooking oil ■ Scissors ■ Hot Pad ■ Toothpick



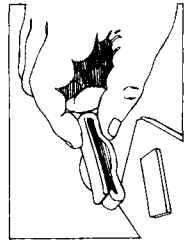
6A. Cut two different colors of plastic strips and place them touching each other in a lightly oiled pan.

Heat 2 minutes

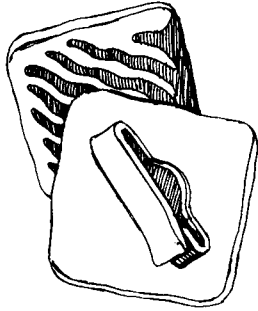


6B. Remove pan with pan holder and place on hot pad without removing plastic. While still hot, carefully swirl the two plastics together where they touch using a toothpick.

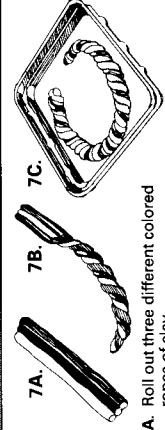
Cool 2 minutes



6C. Remove plastic and wipe off excess oil or wash with soap and dry. Attach earrings or barrettes with small pieces of adhesive foam tape. Wear it with style!



EZ BRACELETS



7A. Roll out three different colored ropes of clay.

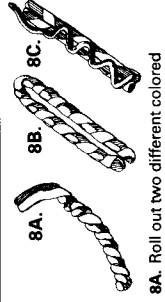


7B. Twist the ropes together as shown.

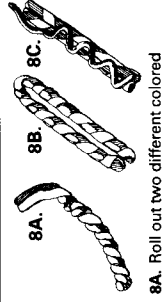


7C. Size the bracelet around your wrist and cut off excess. Lightly coat pan with cooking oil and place in pan.

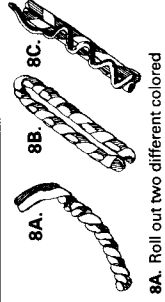
Heat 10 min. - Cool 2 min.



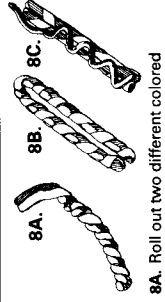
8A. Roll out two different colored ropes of clay. Twist the ropes together.



8B. Roll until rope is smooth and long, then fold in half.



8C. Roll out a thinner, different colored rope, place on top as shown.



Heat 10 min. - Cool 2 min.
