



How to use your FRIENDSHIP TWISTER &


Pull up on end of handle to separate handle unit from hook unit. Find cord locks.




Have an adult cut two or more strands of cord to the desired length, approximately three times the finished length of the necklace or bracelet you wish to make. This allows for the shortening that is due to twisting and for tying of the ends.




Put one end of the selected cords through the front of one of the holes on the handle unit.




Pull the ends through about 1" and firmly press in one of the cord locks from the handle side.




Thread the beads and trinkets you want onto the individual cords. Try putting beads and trinkets on different cords. this allows for rearranging in step 8.




Take the other ends of the cords, and put them through the other hole in the handle unit, securing them with a cord lock.




Place the hook unit over the edge of a table and rotate the metal hook so that it is facing upwards (as shown) by pressing the button on top and turning the green wheel. Then place the middle of the cords over the metal hook.




9 While continuing to squeeze the trigger and applying gentle tension to the cords, allow the handle unit to slide closer to the hook unit as the twisting shortens the cords. If a trinket hits the other cord while you are twisting, simply pull the other cord out of the way and allow the trinket to spin.





10 First twist the cords to the desired tightness (recommended as shown). Next, while keeping cords taut (straight, not sagging), reach with other hand and press button on hook unit. SLOWLY slide handle unit toward hook unit and watch the bracelet or necklace finish twisting itself together. If the cords do not twist together when the button is pressed, release the button, pull handle unit back and pull the trigger a few more times. Then press button again.







11 Now take the finished bracelet or necklace off the metal hook first. It will not unravel.







19 Knot them to each other as shown.



To finish off the bracelet or necklace, thread half of the loose ends through the loop end (as shown) and knot together with the remaining loose ends in a double knot (have an adult cut off extra cord if desired). The ends can be tied in a bow instead to allow reuse.

15 Extra beads and trinkets can be stored in the storage compartments in hook unit. Replace handle unit when finished making bracelets or necklaces.

When opening, be careful not to spill trinkets and beads if you have stored any inside.
