(bake at 375°F).

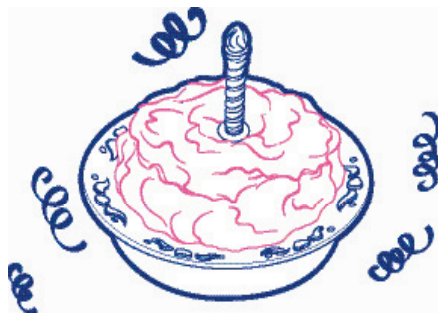
Requires 2 x 1.5V "AAA" or R03 size batteries (not included).
Alkaline batteries recommended. Phillips/cross-head
screwdriver (not included) needed to insert batteries.

This set includes:

- 1 white cake mix
- 1 chocolate frosting mix
- 1 musical cake base
- 1 birthday candle

You will also need:

- mixing bowl
- mixing spoon
- teaspoon
- ½ teaspoon
- non-stick cooking spray

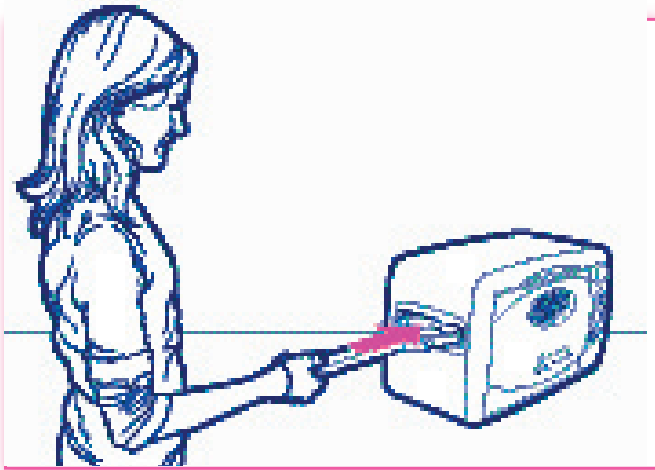

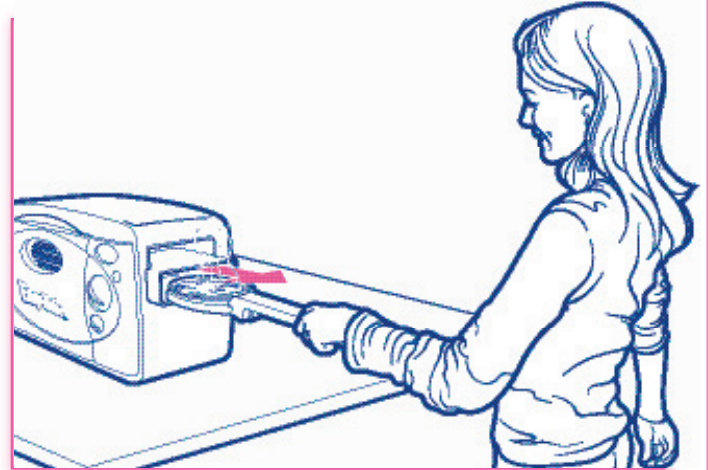

Oven Basics



- 1) Preheat oven for 15 minutes.
- 2) Place baking pan in baking slot, then use pusher end of your pan tool to push pan into oven.
- 3) Make sure both metal doors are closed.
- 4) When baking time is done, use pusher end of pan tool to push through to cooling chamber. PAN IS HOT! Cool for 10 minutes.



- 5) Using holder end of pan tool, remove pan.
- 6) Unplug oven when finished baking. Wait for oven to cool, then wipe it down.

RECIPES

Birthday Cake

Preheat oven for 15 minutes
Spray pan with cooking spray
Makes one cake



1. Pour contents of cake mix into bowl and stir to break up lumps.
2. Add 1½ teaspoons of water and stir to form batter.
2. Pour batter into the baking pan and spread evenly.
3. Follow “Oven Basics” instructions for using your oven.
5. Make sure both metal oven doors are closed. Bake for 10-12 minutes.
6. Let cool for 10 minutes and follow “Chocolate Frosting” instructions.

Chocolate Frosting

Makes enough for one cake

1. Pour contents of frosting mix into a bowl.
2. Add ½ teaspoon of water and stir until smooth.
For thinner frosting, stir in a few extra drops of water.
3. Spread frosting over cake.

To Play the “Happy Birthday” Song

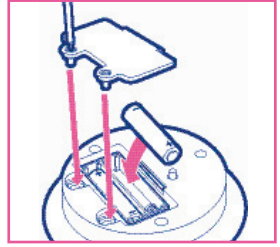
1. Place musical plate flat on table.
2. Remove a dime-size hole from center of cake.
3. Place cake onto plate so center candle mount is visible through hole in cake. Insert end of candle into center candle mount.
4. See the candle light up and hear the “Happy Birthday” song!
5. Eat and enjoy!

TO INSERT BATTERIES

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver to remove screws in battery cover. Remove cover and insert 2 x 1.5V “AAA” or R03 size batteries. Alkaline batteries recommended. Replace cover and tighten screws.



CAUTION:

1. As with all small batteries, the batteries used with this toy should be kept away from small children who still put things in their mouths. Batteries should be replaced by an adult.

CAUTION:

1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert item correctly by matching the + and – polarity markings.
2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
6. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
7. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.
