Thank you for purchasing the FURREAL FRIENDS Newborn LUV CUBS pet, the baby bear cub that moves and sounds like a REAL cub!

Requires 3 x 1.5V "AAA" or LR03 size alkaline batteries (not included). Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) needed to insert batteries.

Newborn LUV CUBS are lovable, cuddly baby bear cubs that belong right in your arms! Tickle their tummy and they will stretch out their arms to ask for your care. Watch their eyes open and close and listen to them make adorable baby bear cub sounds! Pet the soft fur on their back as you hug them. When they're hungry "feed" them with their very own baby bear cub bottle.

Be sure to take good care of your Newborn LUV CUBS by following the instructions in this booklet!

To begin playing with your Newborn LUV CUBS you must first install batteries.

TO INSTALL BATTERIES

Pull back the plush flap on the back of the Newborn LUV CUBS bear cub. Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver to loosen screw in battery compartment cover (screw stays attached to cover) on the bottom. Insert 3 x 1.5V "AAA" or LR03 size alkaline batteries (not included). Replace cover and tighten screw.



NOTE: Your Newborn LUV CUBS bear cub will automatically go to sleep when the batteries are inserted. You can wake your Newborn LUV CUBS up by changing the ON/OFF switch to "ON."





CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- 1. As with all small batteries, the batteries used with this toy should be kept away from small children who still put things in their mouths. If they are swallowed, promptly see a doctor and, in the U.S., have the doctor phone (202) 625-3333 collect, or, in Canada, have the doctor call your provincial Poison Control Centre.
- 2. Make sure the batteries are inserted correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions:
- 3. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickelcadmium) batteries.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Please retain this information for future reference. Batteries should be replaced by an adult.




CAUTION:

- 1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert item correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- 6. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
- 7. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.
- 8. As with all small items, these batteries should be kept away from children. If swallowed, seek medical attention immediately.

FURREAL FRIENDS Newborn LUV CUBS consist of the following parts:




Your Newborn LUV CUBS makes a variety of realistic baby bear cub sounds and really:

HOW TO PLAY WITH YOUR NEWBORN LUV CUBS

To turn your Newborn LUV CUBS ON, pull back the plush flap over the battery door and switch the ON/OFF switch to ON. Then replace the flap.



Once your Newborn LUV CUBS bear cub is turned on, he will sigh, stretch and then open his eyes to wake up. He is now ready to play with you!

NOTE: Your Newborn LUV CUBS will go to sleep and shut down if he is not played with for approximately a minute. You can wake him up by tickling his tummy! Please remember to turn the ON/OFF switch to the OFF position when you are not playing with your Newborn LUV CUBS, in order to conserve battery life.




To start playing with your Newborn LUV CUBS, tickle his tummy!



His arms are poseable too! Move them up or down to make him look cute!



To make your Newborn LUV CUBS sleepy, cuddle him and hold down his tummy sensor for 5 seconds and he will get sleepy and make cute baby bear cub sounds. To wake him up again, begin tickling his tummy and watch him move!



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

To clean your Newborn LUV CUBS fur, gently brush him with a cloth or soft brush to loosen any dirt. Then use a slightly damp cloth to remove stains.

- DO NOT PUT IN THE WASHING MACHINE
- DO NOT SUBMERGE IN WATER
- DO NOT GET WET EXCEPT A DAMP CLOTH ON THE FUR
- TO PREVENT STAINING THE FUR, WIPE DIRT OFF IMMEDIATELY
- IF THE Newborn LUV CUBS GETS WET, REMOVE THE BATTERIES AND DRY THE FUR
- ONCE COMPLETELY DRY, REPLACE THE BATTERIES
- DO NOT USE DETERGENT OR STAIN REMOVERS ON THE FUR



High temperature will destroy the unit. Do not leave unit in direct sunlight.

- Prevent spills of food and beverage on the unit.
- Do not throw or kick the product, and do not push sharp objects through the speaker openings.
