


SKY SWEEPER™ JET


Includes 2 x 1.5v AAA/R03 batteries.
Phillips/crosshead screwdriver (not included) needed to replace batteries.


Includes jet, spy plane, SOUND ATTACK™ weapon, 2 missiles and instructions.







SKY SWEEPER™ JET INSTRUCTIONS










To fire missiles:

- 1. Push tail back. (ILL.1)
- 2. Open weapon compartments as shown. Load missiles into launchers. Press buttons to fire. (ILL.2)

Spy plane:

- 1. To remove plane from jet, hold fin and pull plane out of jet. Open wings. (ILL.1)
- 2. To replace plane in jet, close wings. Insert post on jet into hole in plane. Swing plane down until it locks in place. (ILL.2)



To replace batteries:

Using a Phillips/crosshead screwdriver (not included), loosen screw in battery compartment cover. Remove cover. Remove and discard batteries. Insert 2 x 1.5v AAA/R03 batteries. We recommend alkaline batteries. Replace door, and tighten screw with screwdriver. See diagrams for polarity.

riangle Caution:

- 1) As with all small batteries, the batteries used with this toy should be kept away from small children who still put things in their mouths. If they are swallowed, promptly see a doctor and have the doctor phone (202) 625-3333 collect.
- 2) Make sure the batteries are inserted correctly and follow the toy and battery manufacturer's instructions.

Please retain this information for future reference.

Batteries should be replaced by an adult.

- 1) Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and polarity markings.
- 2) Do not mix old batteries and new batteries, or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3) Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4) Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5) Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- 6) Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from the other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
- 7) RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of battery. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.
