



Glo'n Go™ Night Lamp

Includes: Gloworm® light, star base, AC adapter and instructions.

Dear Parent,

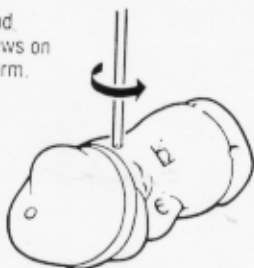
Thank you for choosing this unique two-in-one night lamp and portable light from Playskool Baby. When placed in the star base, Gloworm operates on electrical power, glowing softly to provide comfort for baby. When removed from the base, Gloworm becomes a battery powered take-along light that lets you check on your sleeping child. As baby becomes a toddler, he or she can use Gloworm as a handy night light to help lead the way in the dark.

As always, when it comes to the care and growth of your baby, you can expect the very best products from Playskool Baby.

TO INSERT BATTERIES

What's Needed: 2 "AA" batteries (alkaline recommended) and small Phillips® screwdriver.

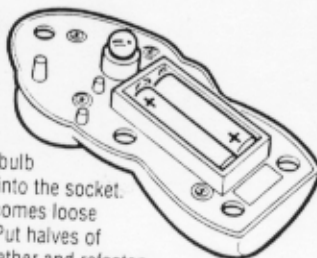
1. Unscrew and remove 5 screws on back of Gloworm.



2. Pull 2 halves of Gloworm apart.



3. Insert batteries as indicated in battery compartment.
Note: During this step, check to be sure that the light bulb is screwed tightly into the socket. (Bulb sometimes comes loose during shipping.) Put halves of Gloworm back together and refasten screws. Now Gloworm is ready to use!



CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions.
- Never mix old batteries and new batteries, or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- Always remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- Remove batteries if product is stored for a long period of time.

TO USE AS A NIGHT LAMP

PLUG the power cord on the base into any 115-volt outlet.

PLACE Gloworm securely into the base as shown.

TURN the switch on Gloworm's back to "ON." Gloworm will glow softly—perfect for comforting baby at bedtime. Note: When used as a night lamp, Gloworm will work without batteries.



TO USE AS A PORTABLE NIGHT LIGHT (batteries must be in the unit)

REMOVE Gloworm from the base.

TURN the switch on Gloworm's back to "ON." Gloworm shines brighter when out of the base; it's perfect for checking on sleeping baby or to help toddlers find their way in the dark.

Note: When removed from the base, Gloworm must have batteries in order to work. If Gloworm is left on for a long period of time when out of the base, batteries will soon weaken. Operating Gloworm on electrical power conserves battery life.

TO REPLACE BULB

Before replacing a bulb, check to see that it is screwed securely into the socket. (A bulb that's loose may fail to light.) Replace burned out bulb with a 1.5-volt, .2A bulb, available at most electrical and hardware stores.
