

**CONTENTS:** Gameboard • 4 Princess Pawns with Stands • 4 Gowns • 4 Crowns • 4 Purses • 4 Bouquets • Dressing Room Assembly (2 Base Pieces, 4 Dressing Room Partitions and Cap) • Die • 20 Cardboard Tokens

# Object

Be the first Princess to return to the castle after collecting your gown, purse, bouquet and crown.

### First time you play

- 1. Carefully detach the dressing room partitions and tokens from the cardboard parts sheet. Discard the waste.
- 2. Open the gameboard and lay it flat on the table.
- 3. Remove the Princess pawns and accessories from the plastic storage tray. Remove the plastic slip from under each Princess' gown and discard. Then remove the gown from each Princess pawn and set aside. NOTE: You may wish to keep the tray to restore the Princess pawns and accessories once you are done playing.

## Setting up the kingdom

1. Snap together the dressing room base pieces as shown in Figure 1.

- 2. Place dressing room base into cutout in the center of the gameboard. You may have to rotate the base a little to get it into place.
- 3. Fold the four dressing room partitions at the score lines. Notice that each dressing room is labeled so you know which Princess it belongs to.

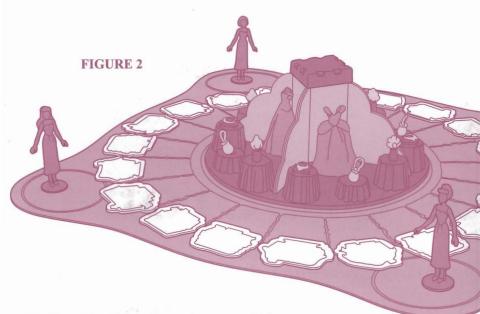
Insert Cinderella's dressing room into the base so that it faces her castle. Going clockwise, insert the remaining dressing rooms into the base in the following order: Sleeping Beauty, Snow White and Beauty and the Beast.

Make sure that each dressing room is across from the matching castle.

- 4. Place the plastic cap over the top of the dressing room partition pieces to hold them in place.
- 5. Each player chooses a Princess pawn, places her on a clear plastic stand and moves her to the appropriate castle. Place any unused pawns out of the game.
- 6. Place each Princess' gown, purse, bouquet and crown into her dressing room as shown. Notice that each Princess is represented by a different color: Snow White is purple, Cinderella is blue, Aurora (Sleeping Beauty) is pink and Belle (Beauty and the Beast) is yellow.
- 7. Mix up the cardboard tokens and place them on the shop spaces, with the picture of the shop facing up. Be careful not to see the picture on the side that is facing down. See Figure 2 for complete setup.

# Get ready for the ball!

Each player rolls the die. The player with the highest roll goes first. Play then passes to the left.



#### **Rolling the die and moving your Princess**

Roll the die and move your Princess in either direction on the gameboard path. You may move no more than the amount that you rolled, but you may move less if you would like to.

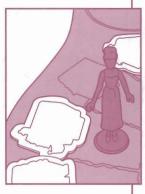
You cannot end your move on the same space as another Princess. If your move ends on a space with another Princess, move ahead to the next open space.

#### Where Did You Land?

If the space you landed on has **no token**, this ends your turn.



If the space you landed on has a **token**, turn it over so all players can see.



#### **Your Princess**

If you turn over a Princess token that shows a picture of your Princess, choose one of your Princess accessories to put on your pawn. Return your pawn to the space you landed on. Discard the token in the game box. This ends your turn.

#### **Another Princess**

If you turn over a Princess token that shows a picture of another Princess, show it to the other players and return it facedown on its spot. This ends your turn.

#### **Coach Token**

If you turn over a Coach token, you can use it to move to any space on the board. You may use the Coach token in the same turn or save it to use during another turn. If you save the coach token to use in another turn, do not roll the die for that turn. Discard the coach token in the game box after you have used it. This ends your turn.

NOTE: If your Princess has collected all of her accessories, and has not yet moved during the turn, you may use the coach token to return to the castle and win the game!

### Winning

The winner is the first Princess to gather all four accessories and return to her castle to await the Prince. If you are the winner you may move your Princess to the top of the dressing room tower, so everyone can see how beautiful your Princess looks in her gown.

### Storage

- Remove gowns and accessories from Princess pawns and dressing rooms. You may either return them to the box or place them back into the display tray for storage. NOTE: If you plan to store them in the display tray, you will need to put the gowns on the Princess pawns.
- 2. Remove all of the dressing room parts and separate the base.
- 3. Return all components to the box.

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
