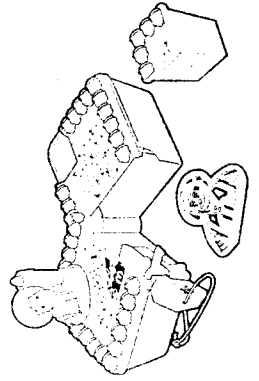
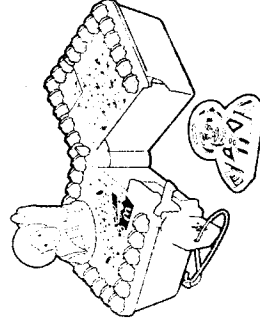
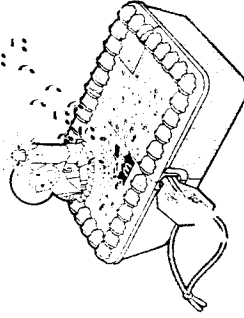
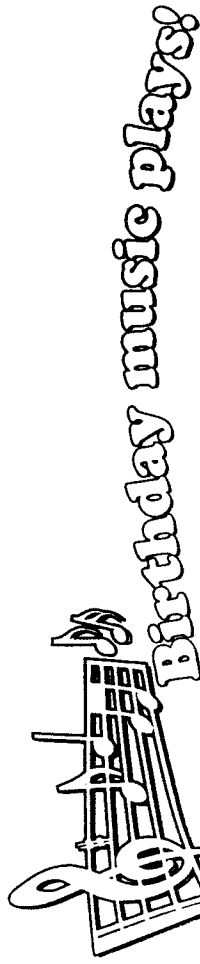
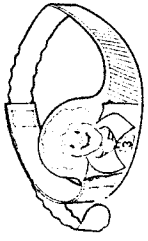
Requires 3 "AA" batteries (not included).

MAGICAL BIRTHDAY CAKE AND BIRTHDAY PARTY KEY:

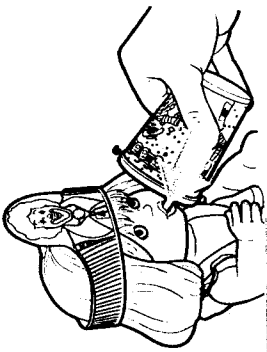
1. Insert key to hear birthday music and see candle light up!

3. Removable piece of cake!

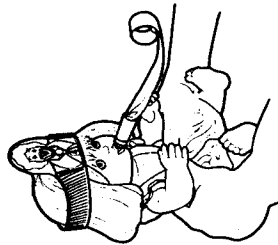
MILKSHAKE:

Press and release straw to change "flavors!"



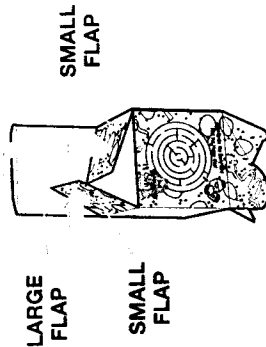
PARTY BLOWER:

Squeeze her tummy - she really blows the party blower!



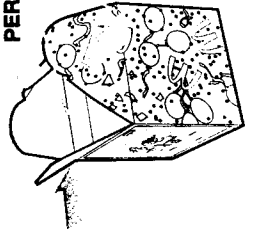
TO FOLD BIRTHDAY BOX:

1. For bottom: fold small flaps, then fold large flap.



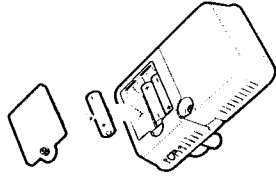
2. For top: bend in perforations until circles overlap. Place stickers in box.

PERFORATIONS



CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions.
2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
3. Always remove weak or dead batteries from the product.



TO INSERT BATTERIES:

- Loosen screw in battery compartment door (screw remains attached to door). Remove door. Insert 3 fresh "AA" batteries into compartment.
- Replace door and tighten screw.
