

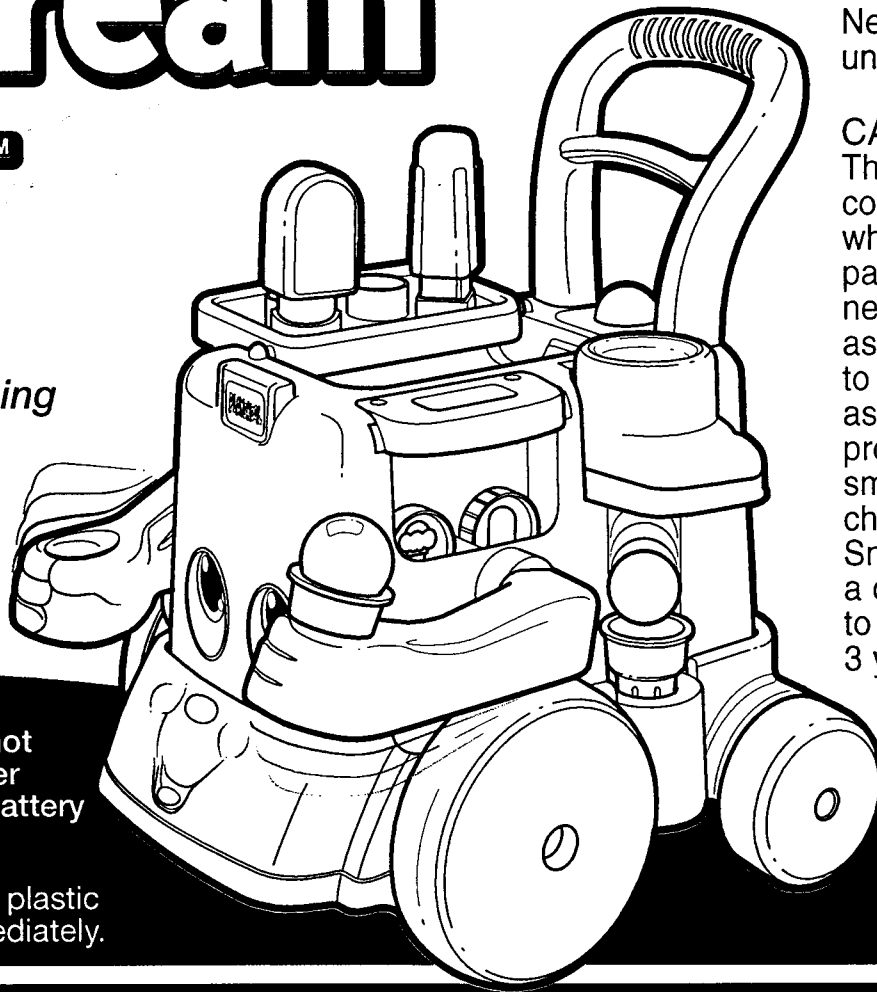

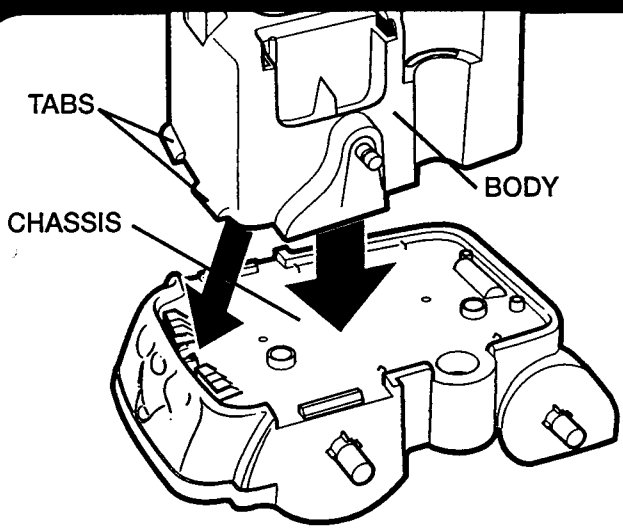

Requires 2 "AA" batteries (not included). Phillips screwdriver (not included) required for battery installation and assembly.

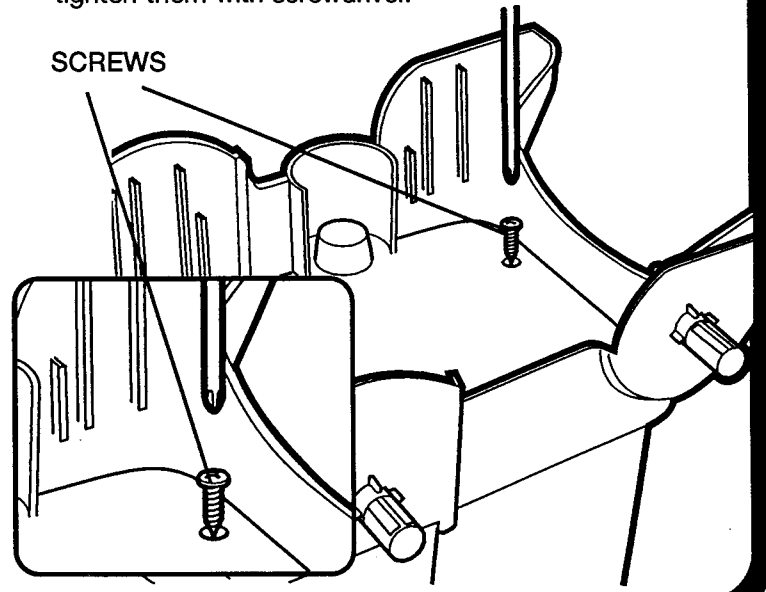
Adults: Remove pieces from plastic bags and discard bags immediately.

BODY AND CHASSIS ASSEMBLY



1. Insert tabs on body into front of chassis, and lower body onto chassis. **Important:** Press against the inside of the body (where the tabs are) to make sure the tabs are completely inserted into the chassis.

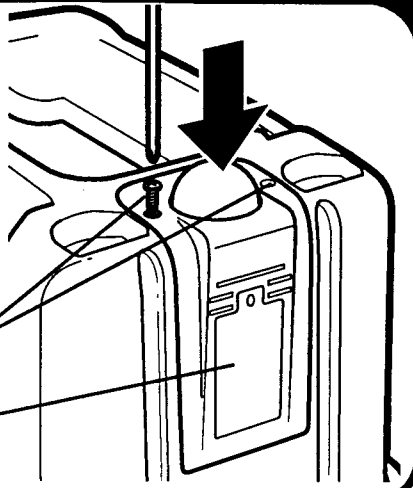
2. Turn assembly over. Insert 2 screws into holes and tighten them with screwdriver.



ELECTRONIC MODULE

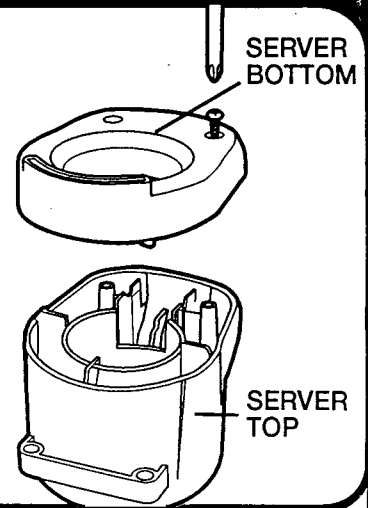
1. Slide electronic module down into slot in rear of cart. Attach module to cart using 2 screws and a screwdriver (not included).

SERVER ASSEMBLY

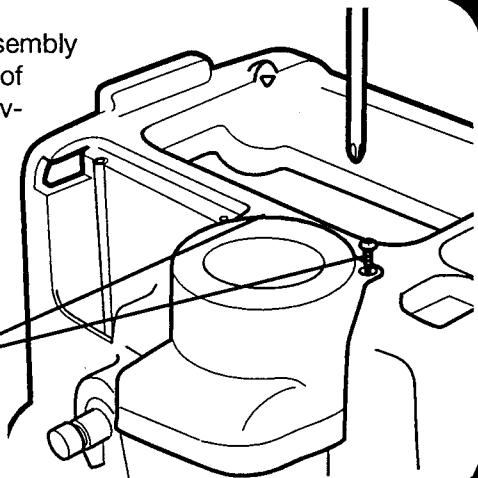
1. Turn server top upside down. Holding server bottom right side up, place it on server top. Attach server assembly together using 2 screws and a screwdriver.



SERVER ASSEMBLY cont.

2. Slide server assembly down into side of cart. Attach server to cart using 2 screws and a screwdriver.

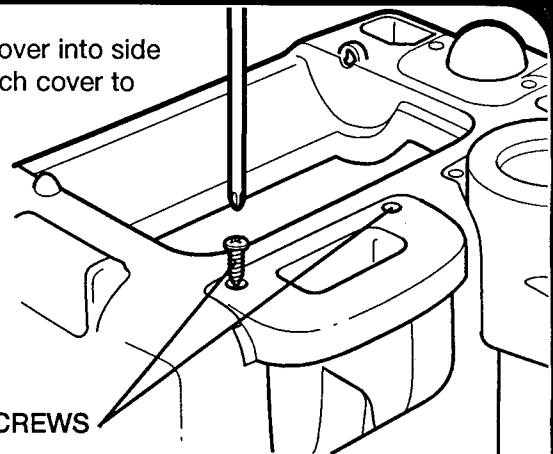
SCREWS



COIN COVER

- Slide coin cover into side of cart. Attach cover to cart using 2 screws and a screwdriver.

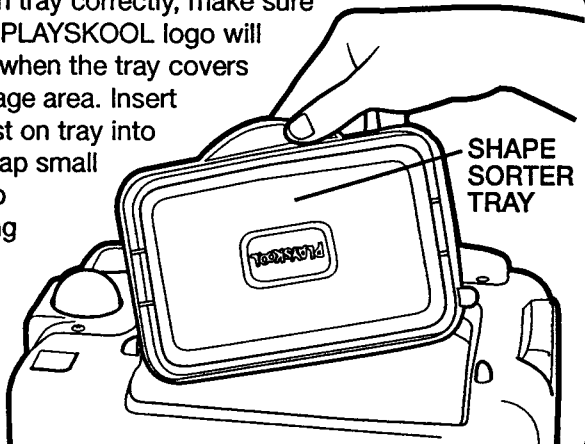
SCREWS



SHAPE-SORTER TRAY

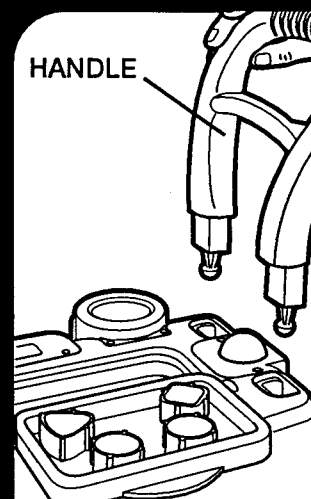
- To attach tray correctly, make sure that the PLAYSKOOL logo will face up when the tray covers the storage area. Insert long post on tray into hole. Snap small post into remaining hole.

SHAPE SORTER TRAY



HANDLE

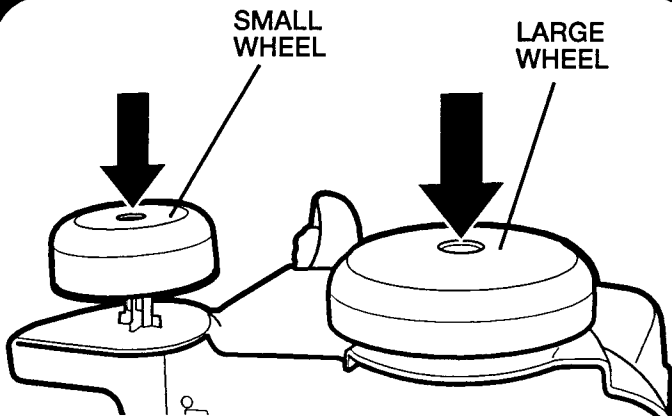
HANDLE



Place cart on floor. Insert ends of handle into holes until handle snaps into place.

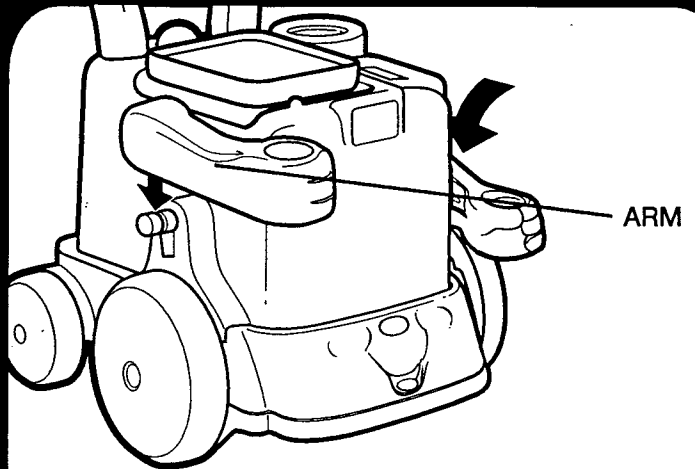
Important: Pull up on each side of handle near the cross-bar to make sure handle is completely snapped into place. It is important to attach handle correctly the first time because it cannot be attached correctly later. The handle will make an audible clicking sound when fully inserted.

WHEELS

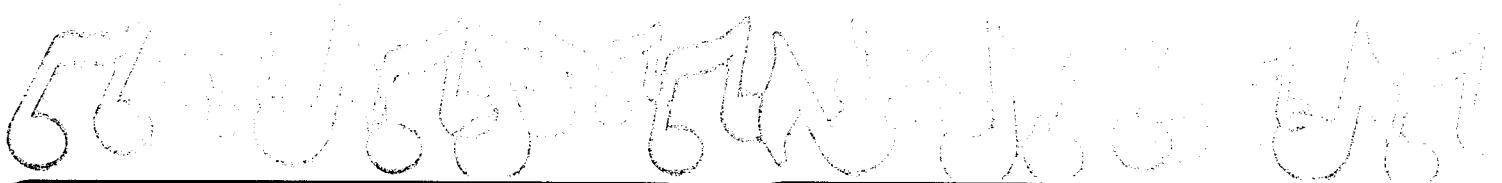


Lay cart on its side. Snap large wheels onto front wheel posts. Snap small wheels onto back wheel posts. Note: You have to press down very firmly when attaching the wheels. It helps to place your hand under the wheel attachment area and push up as you press down on the wheel.

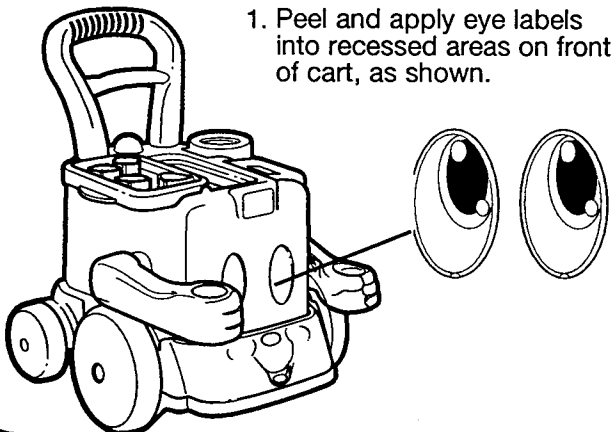
ARMS



Snap arms onto posts on sides of cart. Make sure arms extend forward, as shown in illustration. (The arms are designed to pop off when meeting any resistance, such as if the cart runs into a wall. They easily re-attach to the posts.)



LABELS



1. Peel and apply eye labels into recessed areas on front of cart, as shown.

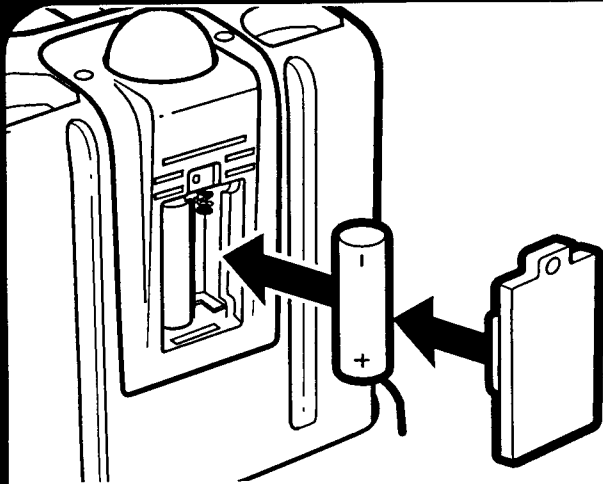
STORAGE

All pieces store in the space under the shape-sorter tray.

PLAY FEATURES

- Press the button on the electronic module to start the music. Push the cart along to make the music continue playing. You can also keep pressing the button to play the music without moving the cart.
- Make pretend ice cream cones! Place a cone in the hole below the server. Place an "ice cream scoop" in the server. The scoop drops down onto the cone!
- Sort the ice pops and ice cream cones in the shape-sorter tray.
- Pay for your treats by dropping the coins through the coin slot.
- Push the cart along and watch the arms go up and down! The ice cream cones fit in the cart's hands for more funny sights!

INSERT BATTERIES



1. Loosen screw in battery door on electronic module (screw will remain attached to door). Remove door, and insert 2 new "AA" batteries (not included). Replace door and tighten screw with screwdriver (not included).



CAUTION:

TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE
