




2. To attach lower double doors to front of stable, slip top tab on one door into top groove in doorway. Snap bottom tab on door into bottom groove in doorway. Repeat for remaining lower double door. Note: you can attach either door to either side of doorway.



 To attach left and right upper double doors to doorway, use same method as described in Step 2, above. NOTE: Attach doors so that slots on back of doors are on top, as shown.



4. Close roof. Position tower, with its 2 tabs facing the front and back of the stable, above the square in the roof. Press down until tabs snap into place. (ILL. A) Press pony weathervane into hole in top of tower. (ILL. B) Press the 3 flags firmly into the 3 holes in the roof. (ILL. C)



5. Fit tabs on hook rack into slots in back door.
Attach back door to doorway in rear of stable, as described in Step 2, above.




6. Place shelf over window in trophy room. You can place the 2 troughs over the other windows so that they are either in or out of the stable, or on the lower double doors so that they face away from the stable.



7. To assemble bed, fit tabs on headboard into slots in bed.



8. You can also take the bed out and place 4 fence sections in the stable. The tabs on the bottom of the fences fit into the slots in the stable floor.




9. To put saddle on a pony, place saddle on pony's back with buckle on pony's right side. Wrap buckle around and under pony. Pull strap through buckle until tab holds it in place. (ILL. A)

You can also insert a flag into the hole in the saddle. (ILL. B)

Place front of bridle over pony's mouth with buckle on pony's left side. Wrap bridle over ears and pull strap through buckle until tab holds it in place. (ILL. C)

Fit the 2 holes in the reins over the 2 posts on the bridle (located on each side of pony's mouth.) (ILL. D)



10. To assemble brush, bring brush handle behind brush and fit hole over peg. Position peg into smaller end of hole.




11. How to braid pony's hair:



- Divide tail into 3 equal sections.
- Cross right section over middle. Bring left section into middle.
- Continue until you reach end of hair. Tie with a ribbon.

12. Use fence sections, A-jump and pole jump to make a show arena. To asemble pole jump, position the bar between the pegs on the 2 poles. (ILL. A).

You can attach an award ribbon to the pony's bridle, as shown. (ILL. B)



13. To carry stable, close back door until you feel and hear it snap into place. Lower roof onto stable. Close upper and lower double doors until they snap



f 14. NOTE: If roof happens to come off during play, simply snap it back on by the hinges, as shown.
