



ASSEMBLY Snap pieces into place as shown:






Crown

Snap ends of crown together. Line up pins (on bottom of crown) with notches on turret; lower crown into place.




Balloon gondola

Snap balloon strings onto gondola, then inflate balloon and close nozzle. Place gondola onto turret.









Spinning disk

Press spinning disk onto top of staircase.

Move the elevator up and down!


Bedroom

Magical mirrored door

To open door, press gently from inside.


To close, lift by hand or press lever next to door.

Place the spinning disk on top of the grand staircase. Place pony's magnetic foot on the heart, then turn the disk and she goes for a ride!




Powder room

Place tutu on hanger and hang in wardrobe!




Stove

When PINK SUNSPARKLE touches the heart on the stove, top flips open to reveal sink with movable faucet!



TO REPLACE BATTERIES

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver to loosen screw in battery compartment door (screw remains attached to door). Remove door and remove old batteries. Insert 3 fresh "AA"/LR6 alkaline batteries. Replace door and tighten screw.



- 1) Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions:
- 2) Do not mix old and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries;

CAUTION:

- 3) Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4) Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5) Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- 6) Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from the other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
- 7) RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of battery. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.
