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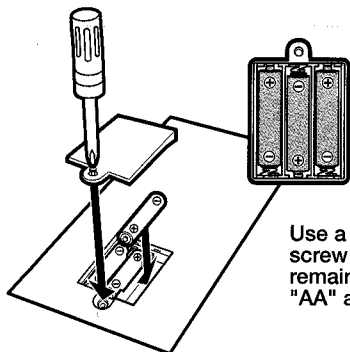


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Requires 3 "AA" alkaline batteries (not included).  
Phillips screwdriver needed to insert batteries.



#### TO REPLACE BATTERIES



Use a crosshead/Phillips screwdriver (not included) to loosen screw in battery compartment door. Remove door (screw remains attached to door) and discard batteries. Insert 3 "AA" alkaline batteries. Replace door and tighten screw.



#### CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions;
2. Do not mix old and new batteries or alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries;
3. Always remove weak or dead batteries from the product.
