


Turn the paper colorside down and fold in half on the diagonal. Then unfold it flat.






Now fold in half on the other diagonal, so the line crisscrosses the first fold. Unfold it flat.






Fold each corner in, so all meet in the middle. (SEE-YOU GET A SMALLER SQUARE!)







Now turn it over and fold each new corner into the middle. (MAKING IT A MUCH SMALLER SQUARE!)





Fold it in half to get a rectangle. Open it up flat. Then fold it up in half, making another rectangle. Now you've got pockets underneath! Stick your thumb and forefinger of each hand into the 4 pockets and open up the Fingers of Fate! (YOU SHOULD HAVE 4 POINTS IN THE ATR!)







Ask someone to choose a number from 1 to 4. Open and close the Fingers of Fate (in and out sideways, then in and out North/South), counting off loudly each opening and closing until you have said that chosen number.

Ask that same someone to choose a color shown inside. Lift up the flap and read the fortune your fingers have foreseen.










First select your symbol by lining up the pointer to one of the 5 code symbols shown at right.
