

PRANKSTER PACK™

Here's everything you need to aggravate your friends, annoy your siblings and make your parents tear their hair out.

This kit is crammed with pranks and practical jokes that you create! There's stuff to cut out, punch out, fold and glue—with 2 kinds of glue! The **Stick It Down, Move It Around Glue Stick** lets you move things once you've stuck them. The **White Glue** is the permanent kind in the bottle. When you stick it with White Glue, it stays stuck. (SO DON'T MIX THEM UP!)

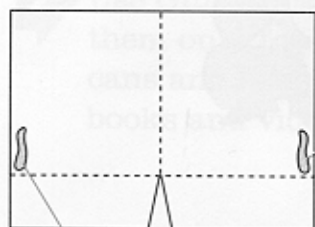


Stick it Down,

- 2 Stick it out from under a rug, a car tire, the fridge...out of your locker or desk. Hang it inside your coat sleeve in the closet.

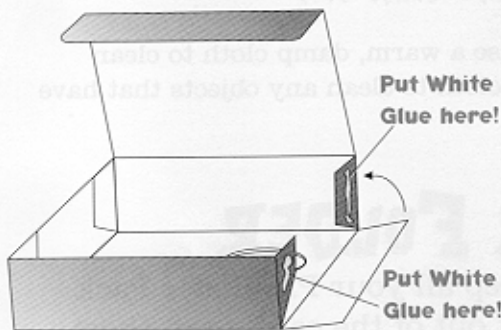


A GRUESOME GIFT: THE SEVERED FINGER

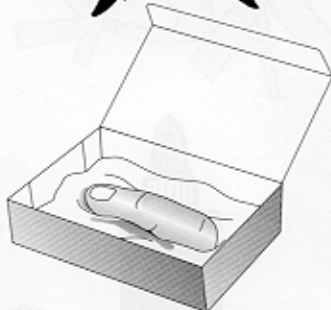
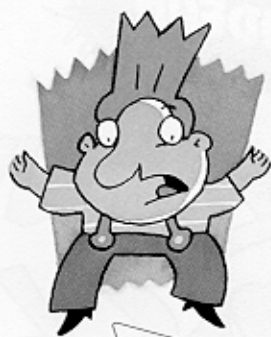
Want to give someone something really special? Try this extra-special gift! Just wait until they open it and find... a gross, chopped-off finger! YOURS! (YECCHHH!)

1 Punch out the gift box from the cardboard sheet.

2 Fold and then glue with White Glue.



3 Put your ring finger through the hole. (DUST WITH BABY POWDER OR FLOUR TO MAKE IT LOOK EVEN MORE DEAD.) Use a red marker to dab some color on some cotton for make-believe blood. After it dries, tuck the cotton around your finger to hide the hole. Close the box and offer it as a gift to some unsuspecting friend or family member.



SURPRISE!

MOUthing- OFF STENCIL

You know those talk/thought balloons used in comic strips? Now you can put your own on glass-framed family photos, schoolbooks and magazine covers! Use our **Mouth Off!** statements on page 11 or make up your own messages!



DON'TS: Don't use the permanent White Glue.

1 Punch out stencil from cardboard platform.

2 Trace a balloon shape on plain paper and cut it out.

3 Cut out your message from page 11.

4 Use Glue Stick to stick your message on the balloon. Then use it to stick the balloon on objects!

When the joke's over, just peel off the balloons and stick them inside your Holder Folder.

Rude Labels and Twisted Titles

Are you ready to spice up the food in your kitchen? Is your bookshelf in need of a facelift? Are those videos dull, dull, dull? Give them new names with **Rude Labels and Twisted Titles**. Here's how!

- 1 Cut labels from pages 11-13.
- 2 Use Glue Stick to tack them onto food jars, cans and boxes—plus books and videos!

Create your own labels, too! Add old photos to your labels—but ask first before you cut them up! (WOULDN'T YOUR LITTLE BROTHER'S PICTURE LOOK GREAT ON A CAN OF DOG FOOD?) Store used labels in your Holder Folder.



DON'TS: Don't use the permanent White Glue. And don't attach labels to medicines, soaps, poisons or household cleaning products.

THE INSTANT CRACK-UP

It's time to put a scare into someone! Peel the Instant Crack-Up off its backing. Apply it to clean glass surfaces, windows and mirrors. Act like it's real and you'll really do a number on someone! Ever wanted to see your sister's picture "smashed"? Or the bathroom mirror "cracked" due to your brother's ugly face?

BAG-O-BUGS

Really want to bug somebody? Use these plastic critters in unique and unusual ways! Here are some ideas to get you started!

- SUSPEND THEM FROM A HANGING THREAD.
- SET THEM ON THE TOILET.
- PUT THEM IN SOMEONE'S BED.



DON'TS: Don't apply it to hot surfaces—like oven windows.



DON'TS: Don't put the little plastic buggers in food or drinks. They should not be eaten (EXCEPT BY PLASTIC ANTEATERS). And don't put them on hot surfaces—they can melt.

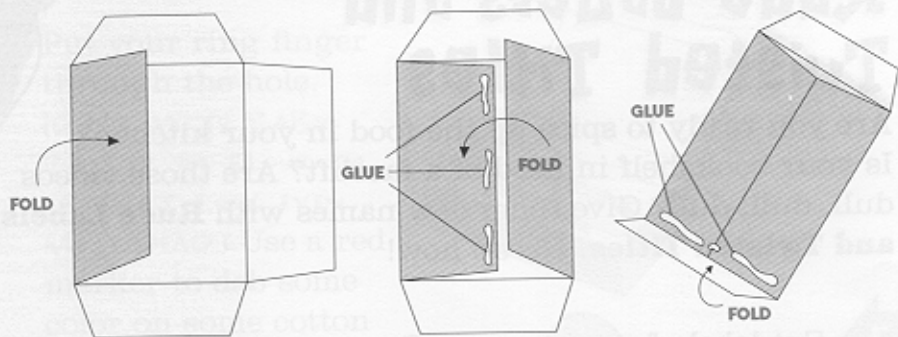


ALLIGATOR EGGS

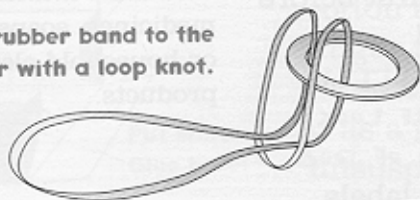
1 Glue Envelope!

Cut out envelope on page 15.
Fold and then glue together
with White Glue.
(DON'T GLUE THE TOP
FLAP SHUT!)

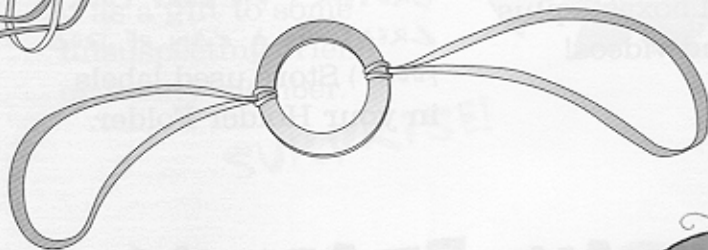


2 Make the Alligator Rattler!

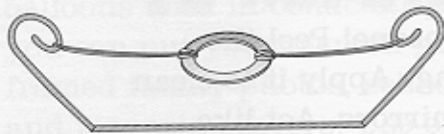
Tie one rubber band to the
washer with a loop knot.



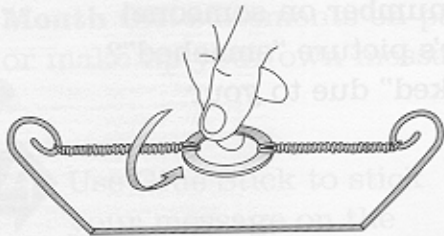
Do the same thing with the
other rubber band so it
looks like this.



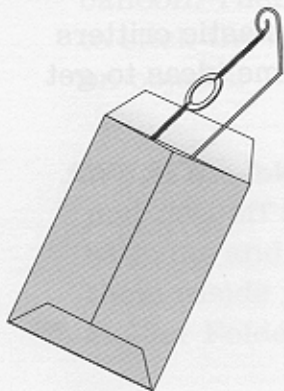
Hook each rubber band's
loop onto the opposite
ends of the wire.



Now wind up the washer
so the rubber band twists a lot.
(DON'T LET GO, OR YOU'LL
HAVE TO START WINDING
ALL OVER AGAIN.)



Carefully slip the alligator
rattler into the envelope
(MAKING SURE IT
DOESN'T UNWIND).



Close envelope and
hand it to a friend
to open!

SURPRISE!

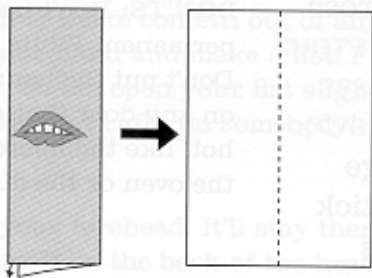
NOTE: You can use the alligator rattler without the envelope, too. Wind it up, put it on a vinyl or leather seat and sit on it. Now stand up slowly. It's windbreaking!

THE WHIPPERSNAPPER

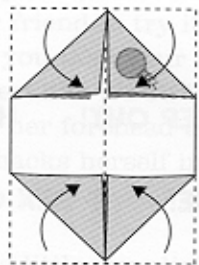
Make people jump! Sneak up behind and startle them with this folded paper nightmare! Just snap it down and you'll hear a loud **POP!** Easy to make—cut out page 17 and then fold it like this:



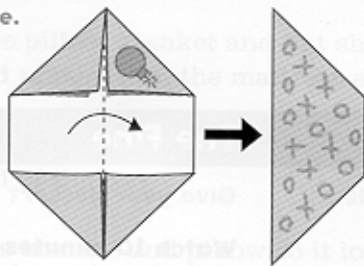
- 1** Fold paper in half down the middle so the smile is upside down. Then open it up flat so the color side is facedown.



- 2** Now fold each corner in so the Nickelodeon™ bomb is in the upper right corner.



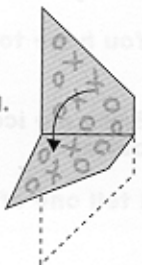
- 3** Fold it in half along the first fold so the corners are inside and you only see the X's and O's side.



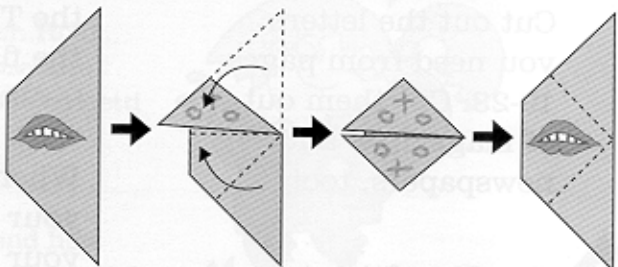
- 4** Now fold the bottom half up.



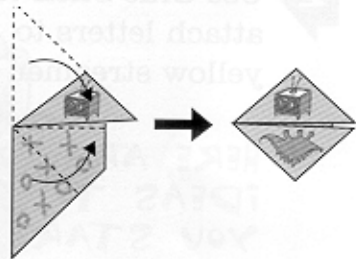
- 5** Undo that last fold. (DON'T ASK QUESTIONS. DO IT.)



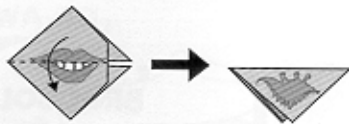
- 6** Now flip it over so the smile is upside down. Fold the 2 long pointed ends in to the center fold line to make a diamond. (Leave a little open space between the points.) Now undo those folds.



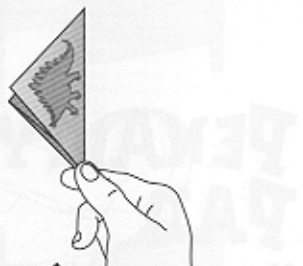
- 7** Flip it over again and fold the 2 long pointed ends in to the center, leaving a little open space between the points.



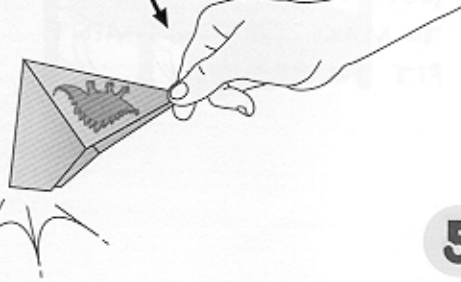
- 8** Now turn it over and then fold it in half so the smile is on the inside.



- 9** Now grab the open end with the 2 long points between your thumb and forefinger. (Hold it at the very tips of the points and make sure the smile inside is facing away from you.)



- 10** Raise it up and snap your arm down quickly, like you're cracking a whip. (It may take a few tries to get a real loud POP!)



ONCE YOU MASTER IT, YOU'LL FIND IT'S HARD TO STOP!



SCREAMER STREAMER!

Now you can make your own streamer (with a personalized message) to stretch across doorways, wrap around friends, label the fridge and put in countless other places only you can think of! Create your own sayings or use one of those listed below.

1 Where Are Those Letters?

Cut out the letters you need from pages 19-23. Cut them out of magazines and newspapers, too!

2 Use Glue Stick to attach letters to yellow streamer.

3 Then place it across the bathroom mirror, the TV—even across the fish tank (**LETTERS FACING OUT—UNLESS YOUR FISH CAN READ**). When you change your message, stick your used letters inside the Holder Folder.



DON'TS: Don't use the permanent White Glue. Don't put the banner on any door that gets hot, like the microwave, the oven or the dishwasher.

The Master Prankster

By now, you're a master prankster. So here are some practical jokes you can do on your own. But before you do any prank, remember this

THE PRANKSTER'S GOLDEN RULE:

(YOU DID IT, YOU DEAL WITH IT.)

EVEN MORE PRANKS TO DO!

Ah-Choo!

Use a hole punch to make confetti out of any kind of paper. Hold the confetti in your hand and make a fist. Pretend to sneeze into your fist. When you do, open your fist slightly and blow the confetti out the other end—and right on somebody!

Brain Power

Press a dime to your forehead. It'll stay there. Show a friend how you can tap yourself on the back of the head (LAUGHTER HERE) and make the dime fall into your palm (IT'S EASY WITH A LITTLE PRACTICE). Now invite your friend to try it. You press the dime into her forehead—but when you take your hand away, secretly remove the dime, too. She'll feel like it's still there. And she won't be able to shake it loose from her forehead no matter how hard (OR FOR HOW LONG) she whacks herself in the back of the head!

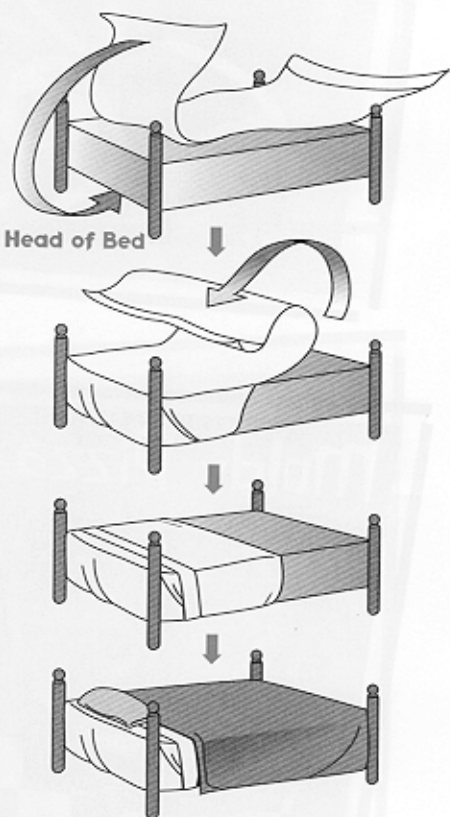
Short-Sheet the Bed!

This is a classic prank that's a little complicated, but it works every time. Make sure the bed has a flat sheet between the fitted bottom sheet and the blanket. Then:

- 1 Remove the pillow, blanket and flat sheet. Tuck the flat sheet's bottom end underneath the mattress at the head of the bed.
- 2 Now take the wide-banded end of the flat sheet and fold it up to the head of the bed.
- 3 Replace the blanket and pillow so it looks as it normally does. (WHEN YOUR VICTIM TRIES TO GET INTO BED, HE OR SHE WON'T GET VERY FAR!)

Toilet-Paper the Bedroom!

After someone falls asleep, grab a roll of toilet paper (RECYCLED BUT NOT USED) and wrap it around the furniture in the bedroom. Bedposts, chairs and doorknobs are good places to wrap around! When morning comes, lie back and hear the commotion!

Abominable Appetizer

Ingredients:

Fresh and soft white bread slices
Chocolate chips
Food coloring

Trim crusts from fresh and soft white bread slices. Roll them into little balls of dough (you can get 1 eyeball from one slice). Stick a chocolate chip pointy-side-in for the pupil. Paint the iris around it with food coloring. Add lots of red lines to make it bloodshot. Serve 2 to a plate.

Slimy Side Dish

Moldy Mashed Potatoes



Ingredients:

Already-made mashed potatoes
Already-cooked spaghetti
Raisins
Food coloring (green)

Mix in a few drops of food coloring into your mashed potatoes. Mix in some wet spaghetti noodles (**NO SAUCE, PLEASE!**) for worms and a few raisins for bugs. Now close your eyes and think about bugs and worms when you eat it—and try not to gag!

Monstrous Main Course

Moldy Pizza



Ingredients:

1/2 English muffin or 1 slice pita bread
Tomato sauce
Shredded mozzarella cheese
Food coloring (green)

Put half an English muffin or a slice of pita bread on a plate and cover with a thin layer of tomato sauce to make a pizza. In a small bowl, mix a handful of shredded mozzarella cheese with a few drops of green food coloring. Stir to coat cheese well, and top the pizza with it. Microwave until melted (about 30-40 seconds). Now cut it up into wedges and watch the slimy green mold drip from each piece.

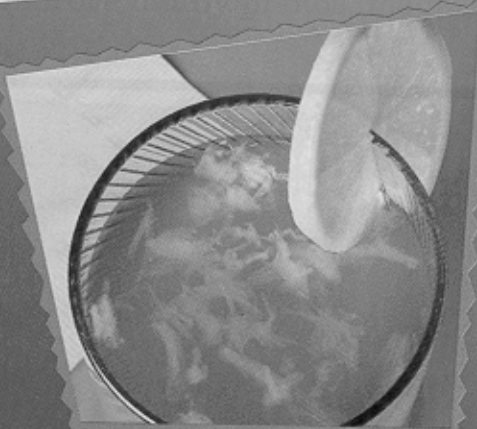
Dreadful Drink

Squished Bug Juice

Ingredients:

Pink lemonade
Food coloring (blue)
Lemon

For freshly squeezed insect innards, take a glass of pink lemonade and add a few drops of blue food coloring. It'll turn blue for fake bug blood. Add lemon pulp (**THE INSIDE JUNK!**) to make flaky bits of insect guts to float around in it.



Dreadful Drink

Wormy Ice Cubes

Ingredients:

Water (or juice)
Soft candy worms
Someone's drink
1 plastic ice cube tray

Put soft candy worms into an ice cube tray. (Have some worms sticking partway out of the cubes.) Add water (or juice) and freeze. Now when your friend asks for a drink, be sure to slip these in.

Disgusting Dessert

Already-Been-Chewed Pudding



Ingredients:

Applesauce (chunky style is best)
Food coloring (green)
Crushed pineapple
Maraschino cherry

Put some applesauce in a bowl. Dye it light green with a few drops of food coloring. Add a little crushed pineapple. If you want, add a maraschino cherry—mashed with a fork so it looks freshly chewed up!

Disgusting Dessert

Dirt Cupcake



Ingredients:

Chocolate-frosted chocolate cupcake
Chocolate cookie
Soft candy worms

Take a chocolate cupcake and crumble a chocolate cookie all over its gooey frosting. (Make sure there is a heavy coating of crumbs—so it looks like dirt!) Put soft candy worms into it so they appear to be crawling out! Then bite into a nice tasty mound of fresh dirt. **YUM!**

Tricky Treat

Meltless Ice Cubes

Ingredients:

½ oz. unflavored gelatin mix
½ cup cold water
1 ½ cups hot water (boil, or microwave 40 seconds)
1 plastic ice cube tray

These frigid fakes will never melt (or float)! But they slide really grossly around in a glass!

Mix together gelatin mix and cold water. Add hot water until gelatin is fully dissolved (**STIR IT**). (Have an adult help out with the hot water part.)

Pour the mixture into the ice cube tray and put it in the refrigerator (**NOT THE FREEZER**). Remove from the refrigerator when the gelatin is firm. To remove cubes, run hot water over the bottom of the tray for about 90 seconds. Run a plastic knife along the edges of each cube and carefully scoop out each cube with a spoon.

Put the cubes in cold drinks and see how long it takes before someone notices! (You can make colored cubes by using flavored gelatin, too. For gross colors, mix flavors—like orange and grape!)

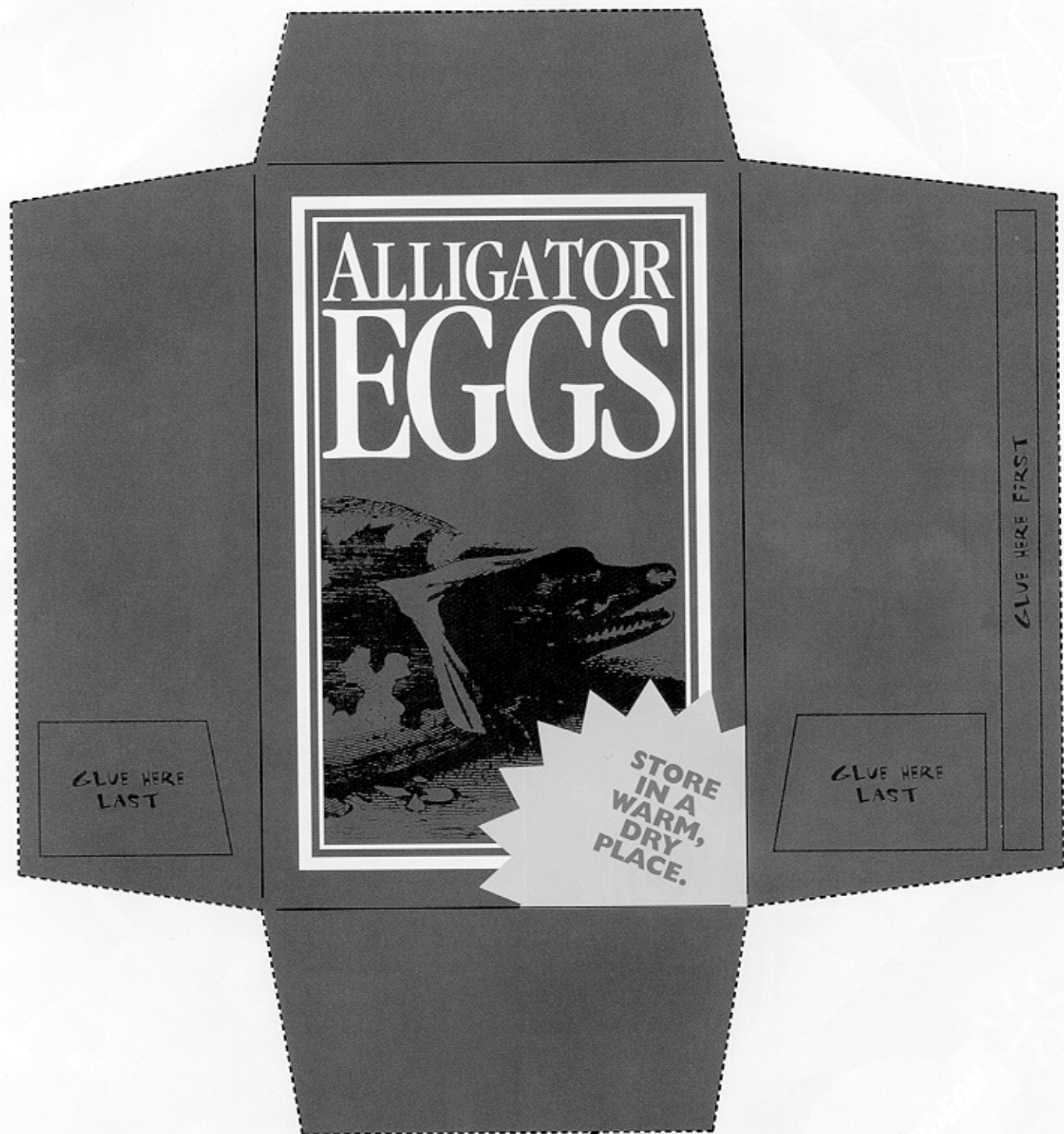

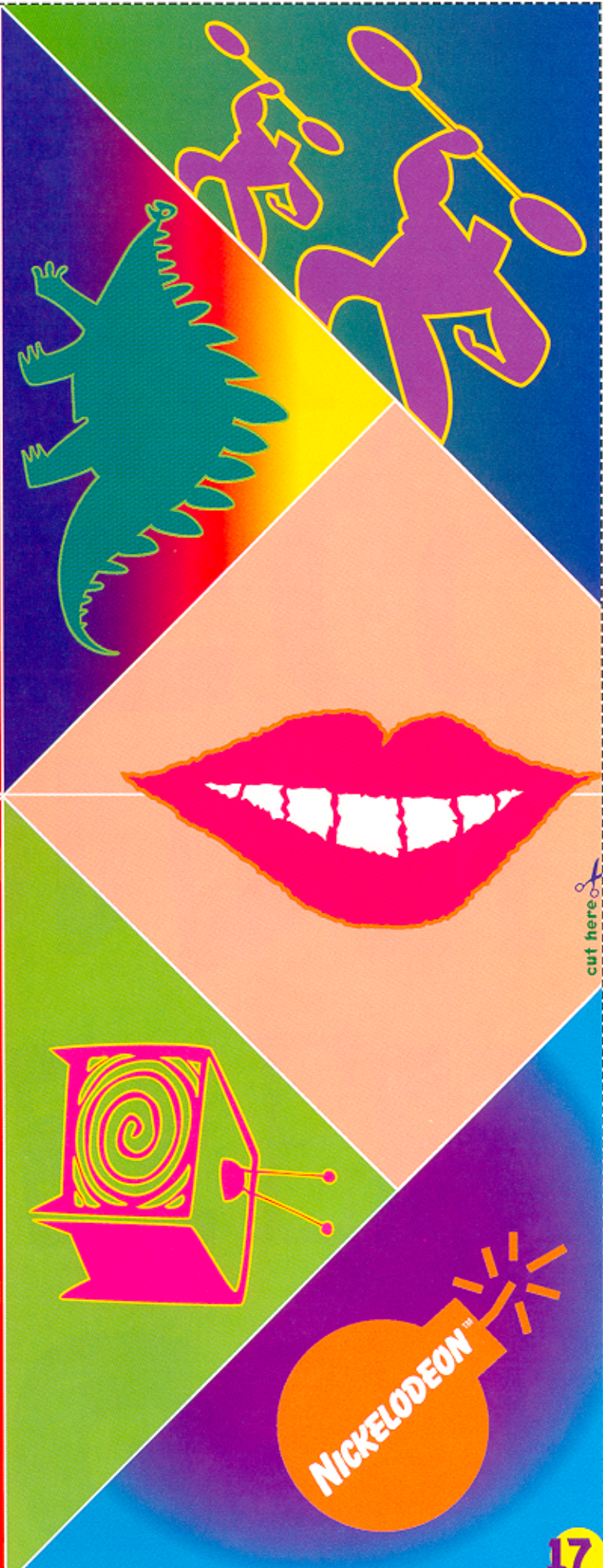
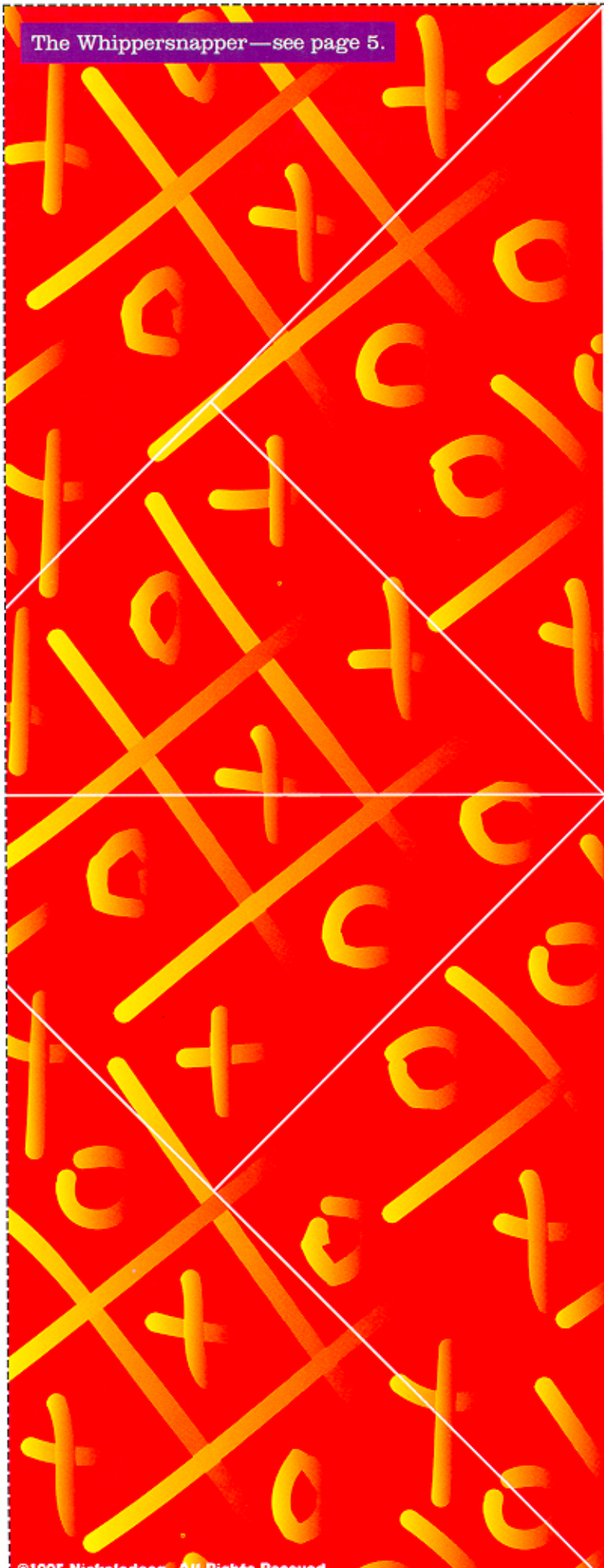
