

The Game About What Girls Always Talk About!

For 2 to 6 players / Ages 8 and up

OBJECT

Players listen to questions read from the different decks of cards then try to match their answers with one another using the heart beepers. If you match with another player, you win a Heart Chip. The first player to collect the required number of pink and purple chips, wins!

EQUIPMENT

PERFECT MATCH™ Game Board • Two Electronic "Heart Beepers"

- 4 Decks of Cards (32 each of Boy Picture Cards, Boy Question Cards, Multiple Choice Cards, Make-a-List Cards) Card Tray
- 36 Heart Chips (18 pink, 18 purple) Pink Plastic Bag for Heart Chips Pad for Writing Lists Token Die

ELECTRONIC HEART BEEPERS

The Beepers will tell if your answer matches another player's.

Try them out: Let's say you've heard a question and your answer is the letter A: Hold the pink Beeper with the letter A pointing up and facing you so the other players can't see the letter; the player on your left holds the purple Beeper so that the letter she thinks you picked is pointed up, facing her. Press the two hearts together: If they BEEP, you matched!

PLEASE: DON'T BREAK YOUR HEART!
Dropping or mishandling the heart beepers could
make them malfunction or break.

SETUP

- Each player will need a pen or pencil for the Make-a-List questions.
- Put the Card Tray in the middle of the Game Board and place each of the four different-colored Card Decks into any slot.
- Place the Token on the yellow START heart on the board. (All players will share this token, which is used only to determine which color card will be drawn.)
- Put all 36 Heart Chips inside the small pink plastic bag.
- Each player rolls the die; the player who rolled the highest number goes first.

▼ NUMBER OF HEART CHIPS YOU NEED TO WIN ▼

- 2 players ♥ 9 Heart Chips of each color to win
- 3-5 players ♥ 4 Heart Chips of each color to win
- 6 players ♥ 3 Heart Chips of each color to win

Here's what the cards mean:

Multiple Choice Cards (Yellow) — Read the question and all four answers aloud to all the players.

Make-A-List Cards (Green) — Read only the top part of the card, which tells you what kind of list to make. Together with your friends, *first*, write the list on the List Pad. *Then* read the question on the card to the other players.

Draw (1 or 4) **Boy Cards** (**Pink**) — (This requires drawing from *two* different piles.) Read the top part of the card then draw either one or four Boy Picture Cards (Lavender) from the other pile; place them face up in order — A, B, C, D — so all players can see them. *Then* read the question on the Pink card to the other players.

Boy Picture Cards (Lavender) — See above.

GAMEPLAY

Note: If you're playing with only one other player, be sure to read the special notes "For 2 Players" below and on the back page.

On your turn, roll the die, move that number of spaces along the board track, and draw the top card from the deck that matches the color of the heart you landed on. Follow the instructions on the card. See the card descriptions, left. (When your turn is over, put the card(s) at the bottom of the deck).

Will you match? Remember, on your turn, the other players are trying to prove how well they know you by matching *your* answer. So when you've made your list or read the question, pick up the PINK Heart Beeper and turn it and hold it so the LETTER of your own answer — A, B, C, or D — is pointed UP and facing you. The player to your immediate left picks up the PURPLE Heart Beeper and turns it so the LETTER of the answer she *thinks* you will give is also pointed up, facing her.

Place your two Heart Beepers together. If you both picked the same answer — the same letter — your two hearts will BEEP in agreement! But if your answers are different, there'll be no beep at all!

If your answers match, you each earn one Heart Chip (see Awarding Heart Chips). But if you did not match, keep your answer secret while the Purple Beeper player tells everyone else what she thought you would answer. She then passes the Purple Beeper to the next player on her left, who tries to guess what your original answer is. Put your two hearts together to see if she guessed correctly. If she did, you both draw a Heart Chip. If not, try with the third player and so on until you finally make a match! But if no one makes a match, then no chips are awarded that round. Note: You may only try to match with any individual player one time — you can't go 'round and 'round until someone guesses correctly.

For 2 players:

If it's your turn and you drew the card, you do not receive a Heart Chip for a match; your opponent receives one chip if she guesses correctly. She gets only one chance to match.

AWARDING HEART CHIPS

- Each time you and another player match correctly, hold up the pink plastic bag of Heart Chips; each of you blindly draws one chip from the bag.
- Heart Chips are drawn only when a match is made.
- Heart Chips are awarded to both the player who asks the question and the player who makes the match.
- If either player already has all the Heart Chips of that color she needs, she must RETURN the just-won chip to the bag; she receives no chip for that round.

For 2 Players:

- Each time the other player matches you correctly, hold up the pink plastic bag of Heart Chips and let her blindly draw one chip from the bag.
- If she already has all the Heart Chips of that color she needs, she must RETURN the just-won chip to the bag; she receives no chip for that round.
