

Make lots of babies for a cradle full of fun!

Basic Play:



Knead modeling compound until it is soft and pliable, and place it in your chosen half mold. Use the rolling pin to roll compound until it completely fills the mold.



Remove excess with trim knife. Use a ball of compound to fill out molded shape.

Advanced play:



Fill the half molds with different compound colors to detail your molded shapes. For example, take a baby mold and use small balls of compound to fill in the individual details (head, hands, booties, etc.).



You may also create a shape, then decorate it with different compound colors. For example, use a small ball of compound to fill in the eyes; carefully remove, trim excess, then apply to the finished shape as shown.

PLAY-DOH® "QUILT":



Turn cradle upside down and lay flat. Roll a flat sheet of compound larger than the baby cradle. Take the compound and press it down onto the cradle. Use the rolling pin to press, then remove quilted shape.



For detailing, you may fill the bottom of the cradle with different compound colors, or use PLAY-DOH® colors to decorate the finished quilt mold.

APPLYING THE LABELS:

Peel and apply labels. Place the label with the kitty onto the front of the cradle footboard, and the label with the lamb onto the cradle headboard.

CLEAN-UP:

When you are finished playing, use a ball of modeling compound to pick up the small pieces of compound off the play area and molds. Replace compounds in their respective cans and seal lids tightly.
