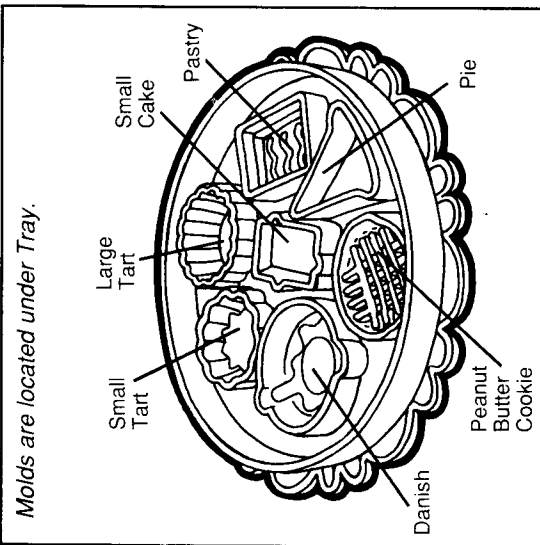
Molds are located inside of Tea Pot.

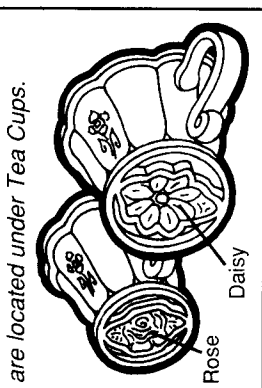

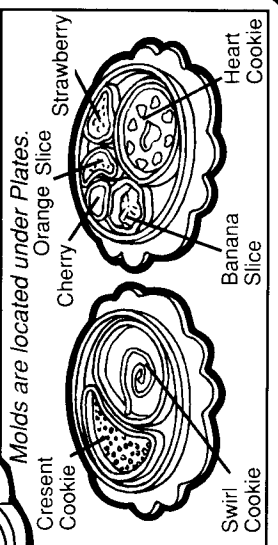

To Use Molds

Cakes, Cookies, Fruit, Pies and decorations can be made from the molds on the bottom of the Plates, Tea Cups, Tray and Sugar Bowl.

Open Tea Pot as shown. Inside are Lemon Slice, Sugar Cube and Tea Bag molds.

Knead a ball of modeling compound until it is soft and pliable and place it into any mold you wish to use. Fill the mold completely.

Remove excess with Cake Server.

Lift out with a ball of modeling compound.

How To Make Cookies

Roll out Play-Doh® Modeling Compound.

After rolling the modeling compound into a flat sheet, press Sugar Bowl Cookie Cutter into modeling compound. Lift out and trim excess with Cake Server.

How To Use The Icing Extruder

Fill back of Creamer almost full of modeling compound.

Push Rolling Pin firmly into hole to make icing. It may be easier to place Rolling Pin on table and press down with Creamer/Extruder.

To Make Cup Cakes

Roll a ball of modeling compound between your hands until you make a cylinder. Insert the cylinder into the Sugar Bowl or a Tea Cup, filling it completely. Next, pull to remove the modeling compound from the mold. Smooth the top with your hands.

Decorating

Use "icing" from Creamer Extruder and fruit from other molds to decorate pastries and cupcakes.

Clean-up

When you are finished playing with your tea set, clean all the modeling compound out of the molds. Use a ball of modeling compound to pick up small pieces, put back into cans and replace lids tightly. Parts can be washed out with mild soap and water if necessary.
