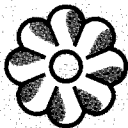
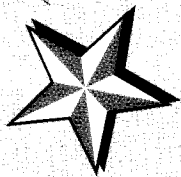

A Message to Parents ...

Art is a wonderful way for children to express their creativity and expand their imaginations. Outlined in this booklet are just some of the stimulating art projects that you and your child can work on together.

Because this activity toy is open-ended in nature, it will encourage experimentation, and assure that each creation will be uniquely successful. And to help ensure that your child's creative experience is a positive one, we suggest that you praise each effort, and display your child's artwork so that he or she will feel a sense of accomplishment.

As an added benefit, the play pattern will help develop fine motor skills, though at least in the beginning, an adult should provide the hands-on guidance needed to complete a project.

We sincerely hope that you and your child enjoy many happy hours exploring and creating with the Press, Stamp 'N Pop™ activity toy. And, as with any child's toy, always remember that the most important step in achieving the maximum benefit is to ...

How to use the Press, Stamp 'N Pop™ activity toy

Before starting, be sure to protect your work area with a plastic cloth or old newspaper.

1. Remove one of the stampers from the design machine base.
2. Press the rubber design on the stamper onto the ink pad in the well, then stamp a design onto the paper.
Note: Ink is washable. Clean stampers by placing them under running water.

Use the Texture Plates to make backgrounds

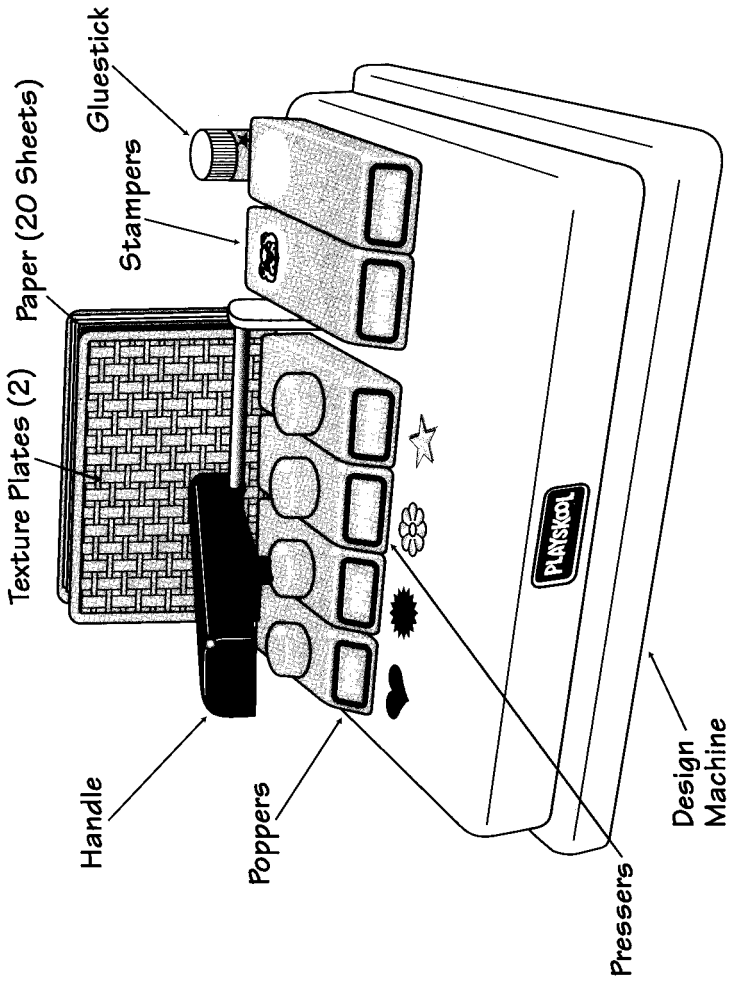
1. Place a sheet of paper (white side up) over either side of the texture plate.
2. Rub the paper with a crayon (not included) to make a textured background for your Press, Stamp 'N Pop™ creation.

To complete your creations, use the gluestick to adhere all the parts you have pressed, stamped and popped!

1. Place sheet of paper under one of the poppers (marked "pop").
2. Slide handle directly over the popper button.
3. Press down on handle to pop a shape out of the paper.
4. Lift up the toy to find the shape that you popped out.

Use the Presser to emboss

1. Place a sheet of paper under one of the pressers (marked "press").
2. Slide handle directly over the presser button.
3. Press down on handle to emboss a design onto the paper.



For these projects, use scissors (not included) to cut out press and stamped shapes.

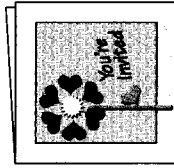
Framed Picture

- Tightly roll a sheet of colored paper into a narrow tube. Glue ends of paper to hold tube together. Make 4 of these.
- On another sheet of colored paper, glue on pressed, popped and stamped shapes, or draw your own pictures.
- Glue one tube across the top and one tube across the bottom of the picture.
- Glue the ends of other 2 tubes on the left and right sides of the picture, on top of the first 2 tubes. Now you have a framed picture that looks ... fabulous!



- Use the Press, Stamp 'N Pop™ activity toy to decorate the holder.

- Grasp 2 corners of a sheet of colored paper and bring them together.
- Fold both corners back.
- Glue one of your shapes across the folded corners to hold them together.
- Decorate your holder with the shapes.
- Slide a napkin into your beautiful new holder!

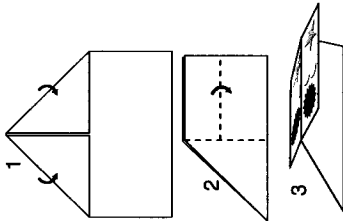


Greeting Cards

- Glue the edges of 2 sheets of colored paper, either down the left side or across the top.
- Decorate the front side of the card by placing it on a texture plate and rubbing a crayon (not included), then adding shapes, embossed designs and stamps to the picture.
- Write a message on the front and inside ... "You're Invited," "Get Well," "Happy Birthday," etc.

Airplane

1. Fold down 2 corners of a sheet of colored paper.
 2. Fold the sheet in half.
 3. Fold down each side as shown.
- Glue together sides to form a plane.
 - Decorate your new flying machine by gluing on decorations from your Press, Stamp 'n Pop set.



- Glue strips together, end to end, until you have enough to form a necklace that easily fits over your head. Glue ends of necklace together.
- Glue the shapes onto the necklace at regular intervals. You've created a colorful necklace that you can wear or display!

Note: To create a bracelet, follow the same steps above but shorten the strip length to fit loosely around your wrist.

These are just a few of the fun projects you can do with the Press, Stamp 'N Pop™ activity toy. But with a touch of imagination and a dash of creativity, you'll find that you and your child can make an endless number of unique and delightful designs!
