Graa	= Hungry

Reees	= Please

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Shelby to English words, with possible phrases.

aaah-geee = again/more

When you rub Shelby's antennas he may say:
deeee,aaah-geeee reees (good,more please)

baae= back

When you rub Shelby's back he may say:
shaah baae deeee (my back[is]happy)

daah-yee = light

When Shelby is tired he may say:
daah-yee uuu-daa reees (light down please)

deeee = good/happy

When you feed Shelby he may say:
yumm,deeee (yumm,good)

graa = eat/hungry

When Shelby is hungry he may say:
shaah graa (shelby hungry)

raaak = love/like/hug

When you rub Shelby's back he may say:
shaaah raaak (shelby love you)

reees = please

When you are feeding Shelby he may say:
aaah-geeee reees (again please)

shaaah = Shelby/me/my

When Shelby is hungry he may say:
shaah suuue, shaah graa, grub (shelby sad, me hungry)

suuuu = sad

When Shelby is sick he may say:
maah graa, shaaah suuuu (no eat, me sad)

uuu-daa = down/under

When Shelby is tired he may say:
daah-yee uuu-daa reees (light down please)

uuuuuu = scared

If you hold Shelby upside down he may say:
shaaah uuuuuu (shelby scared)

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Furbish words that Shelby uses, with example phrases:

ay-ay = look/see

When Shelby wakes up he may say:
