Please note that Soft Vibes Teddy will not calm all babies. It is not intended as a "cure-all" product and may not soothe babies with colic or an




TO REMOVE S TACKING


Cut and remove arread that attaches bear's thumb to bear's mouth before giving product to child.

TO INSTALL BATTERIES & OPERATE BEAR:

Note: This product was designed with your child's safety in mind. It has a child-proof vibration mechanism that must be removed and installed by an adult. Please be aware of this and follow instructions carefully.









2. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, loosen screw in vibration mechanism cover (screw will remain attached to cover). Remove cover.

CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE


- 1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions.
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries.
- 3. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- 4. Always remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.




3. Place 3 "AA" alkaline batteries (not included) into vibration mechanism. Make sure batteries are positioned properly. Replace cover and tighten screw.



4. Fasten fabric ties to vibration mechanism. Insert mechanism into bear. TUMMY SIDE of mechanism should face front of bear. ZIPPER SIDE should face back of bear, with HEAD end inserted toward bear's head, and TAIL end inserted toward bear's tail.



5. Slide switch on vibration mechanism to select either LO or HI vibration speed. Zip bear closed. Press bear's tummy to activate mechanism. It vibrates for 15 minutes before automatically shutting off.



6. To shut off mechanism manually, unzip bear and slide switch to OFF. Zip bear closed. It is recommended that you switch mechanism off when traveling, to prevent accidental activation.

WASHING INF UCTIONS

CAUTION: JO NOT WASH BEAR WITH VIBRATION MECHANISM INSIDE.

To Wash: Remove vibration mechanism before washing. Place bear in pillow case and tie end closed. Machine wash separately--gentle cycle, cold water, mild detergent, no bleach. Tumble dry promptly in pillow case--low heat setting. Replace mechanism -- you may need to rearrange the filling with your hands to make the mechanism fit properly.
