


ASSEMBLY!(

 The top and bottom of the Slave I space ship fit together to make a book mold for making figures of 3 Star Wars characters (Stormtrooper, Princess Leia and Boba Fett). Assemble the top to the bottom by snapfitting hinge on bottom piece over the metal bar on top piece.

2. Press the 2 ship wings into their fittings on each side of the Slave I. The wings and the ship base are marked on the bottom with "R" and "L" for assembly on right and left sides of the ship.



MOLD!


- 1. Take a small ball of Air Hardening Compound and roll or knead it with your fingers to soften and smooth it. Try to remove any cracks or "lines" that may be in the compound.
- 2. For best results, make one figure at a time. Place compound inside figure mold. Close and press the book mold all the way down, open it, and remove excess compound from around the figure. Then close and press the book mold down once more for best molding results.
- 3. Open the book mold and carefully remove the finished figure.

 HINT: Tap the mold on a hard surface if the figure sticks in the mold.

 The mold can be washed with water to remove any residue or build-up.


DRY!

4. When your figures are ready to dry, place them (in a standing position) out in a dry spot with circulating air (for example, a window sill or the top of a refrigerator). Recommended "drying time" is overnight, or 12 hours. NOTE: Drying time is directly affected by weather conditions. In hot or humid climates, more drying time may be needed.



CUSTOMIZE!

5 When your figures are completely hard to the touch, use the markers to color, decorate and customize them in any way you want! HINT: Color lightly, with easy pressure.
