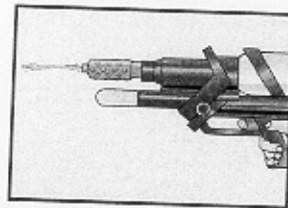
1. Unscrew bottle from blaster. Fill water tank 2/3 full with clean tap water. Replace bottle by screwing all the way in.



2. Pump hand pump 15 to 25 times to build up pressure. When your Super Soaker® becomes difficult to pump, discontinue pumping and start blasting away.



3. Rotate pulsating nozzle in either direction to select between pulsating action and a constant stream of Super Soaker® power.



4. Pull trigger to blast away.
