

TO SET THE ALARM:

Press SET button in normal display mode to display the ALARM DISPLAY. To set the ALARM ON press the MODE button once and the bell symbol will appear on the screen. To have an hourly cuckoo chime, press SET again and the sound symbol will appear on screen.

TO SET THE ALARM TIME:

MODE HOUR display and it also shows the AM and PM. Press the MODE button to change the HOUR and AM/PM display.

Press the SET button again to set the MINUTE display. Press the MODE button to change the MINUTES.

To skip the alarm setting mode, press the SET button 4 times to go directly to the MONTH/DATE/TIME SETTING MODE.



TO SET THE MONTH:

Press SET button in normal display mode to display the MONTH. Set the MONTH by pressing the MODE button.

TO SET THE DATE:

Press the SET button again to reach the DATE display. Advance the date by pressing the MODE button.


TO SET THE TIME:

EFFECTS

Press the SET button again to read the HOUR display and it also shows the AM and PM. Press the MODE button to change the HOUR and AM/PM.

PLEASE NOTE: You can set the time either in 12 or 24 hour mode (military time). Keep pressing the mode button until you reach the hour you want to set. The time will cycle through all the 12 hour choices and then automatically cycle through the 24 hour choices. Do not need to press SET again, just need to keep pressing the MODE button until you reach the time to be set.

Press SET button again to set the MINUTE display. Press the MODE button to change the MINUTES and the SECOND counter will be reset to zero. The COLON will stop flashing when the watch is set.



HOLD MODE:

The watch enters HOLD mode with the next press of the SET button. In this mode the display shows HOUR and MINUTES and a non-flashing COLON.

Press the MODE button once to reset to normal display mode.

NOTE:

If MINUTES were not changed in MINUTE mode, the watch will not enter the HOLD mode but will automatically revert to normal display mode.

STANDARD DISPLAY:

Press MODE button once and the ALARM DISPLAY will be displayed. This will continue to be displayed two seconds after the MODE button is pressed and then will return to the HOUR and MINULE CISPLAY.

Press MODE button twice and the MONTH and DATE will be displayed. This will continue to be displayed two seconds after the MODE button is pressed and then will return to the HOUR and MINUTE display.

Press the MODE button 3 TIMES and the seconds will be displayed. Pressing the SET button will cause the SECONDS to reset and hold the SECOND counter until the SET button is released. By pressing the MODE button again will return to the HOUR and MINUTE display.

RECORD AND PLAY:

Press the button marked with the RED RECORDING markings for recording. Press the button again to stop recording or until memory full. The RED LED will light up when you are recording.

When finished recording press the GREEN play button to hear your message. There is 6 seconds of record and playback time.

VOICE CHANGER:

To manipulate what you have recorded, slide the YOICE CHANGER switch to one of the three different modes of FAST, NORMAL and SLOW.

If message is recorded in NORMAL position - When playing back your message in FAST position, the message will be faster.

SLOW position, the message will be slower.

NORMAL position, the message will be normal speed.

If message is recorded in FAST position - When playing back your message in

FAST position, the message will be normal speed. SLOW position, the message will be very, very slow. NORMAL position, the message will slow.

If message is recorded in SLOW position - When playing back your message in FAST position, the message will be very, very fast. SLOW position, the message will be normal speed. NORMAL position, the message will be fast.

SOUND EFFECTS:

Press one of the two BLUE sound effects buttons to hear the ear shocking sound effects of the the cuckoo clock and the space blast.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT:

CAUTION: BATTERIES SHOULD BE REPLACED BY AN ADULT.

1. On the back of the watch, remove the 4 screws at the corners.

Remove the back cover of the watch. Be very careful when removing the back because the electronics of the watch will be easily visible.

 Remove the batteries and replace with 3 x G13-A/LR44 Alkaline with the (+) symbols facing upwards.

4. Replace the battery cover and the screws.

Do not mix new and old batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard or rechargeable batteries.

90-DAY LIMITED WARRANTY


 Pack the product carefully in the original box or use a good-quality carton with packing materials.
