



SLEEP MODE:


After a short time of inactivity, Cookie Monster's MP3 Player will go to sleep mode. Turn the dial or press the center button to reactivate.

Troubleshooting:

If Cookie Monster's MP3 Player is unresponsive, or if the sounds become erratic, replace batteries

TO REPLACE BATTERIES:

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screw in battery compartment cover (screw remains attached to cover). Remove cover. Remove and discard old batteries. Replace with fresh 2 x 1.5V "AAA" or R03 size batteries. (Alkaline batteries recommended). Replace cover and tighten screw.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- As with all small batteries, the batteries used with this toy should be kept away from small children who still
 put things in their mouths. If they are swallowed, promptly see a doctor and have the doctor phone (202) 6253333 collect. If you reside outside the United States, have the doctor call your local poison control center.
- Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and – polarity markings.
- 3. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 4. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 5. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 6. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- 7. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
- 8. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.
