

BATTERIES INCLUDED

Replace with 3 x 1.5V "AAA" or LR03 size alkaline batteries. Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) needed to replace batteries.

Note to consumer: This toy is packaged in "TRY ME" mode. When you bring the toy home, activate its full range of features by moving the toy's TRY ME/OFF/ON switch to the "ON" position.

Getting to Know Your Pet



Back sensor

When you pet your toy puppy on its back, it will stretch out its front legs, bark, blink its eyes, and move its tail!

TRY ME/OFF/ON

Switch and battery door on tummy.

A sensor is a part of the toy that responds to your touch!


How to Play



To activate your toy puppy, slide the TRY ME/OFF/ ON switch on puppy's belly to the ON position. Your puppy is now ready to play.

Play Mode

Your toy puppy responds to your touch by moving up and down, blinking, wagging its tail, and making lots of puppy sounds!



Calm Mode

If you press and hold down your toy puppy's back for a few seconds, it will stretch its front

legs. It will also make calm noises and slow, small movements. It will then "go to sleep." To "wake it up" and return to Play Mode, pet its back again.



Sleep Mode

After a few moments of non-activation, your puppy toy will bark a little to get your attention. It will also move up and down a few times. After a few more moments of non-activation, it will "go to sleep." To "wake it up" and return to Play Mode, pet its back again.

NOTE: This toy uses battery power whenever its switch is in the "ON" position. When you're not playing with the toy, move its switch to the "OFF" position to help conserve battery life.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your pet doesn't seem to respond properly, first try sliding the OFF/ON switch to OFF, then back to ON. If that doesn't work, you may need to replace the batteries.

CLEANING & CARE

To clean your pet, gently brush its fur with a cloth or soft brush to loosen any dirt. Then use a slightly damp cloth to remove stains.

- Do not put in washing machine.
- Do not submerge in water.
- · Do not use detergent or stain removers on fur.
- Do not get wet; to remove stains, use only a slightly damp cloth on the fur.
- To prevent staining fur, wipe off dirt immediately.
- If toy gets wet, remove batteries and dry fur; once fur is completely dry, replace batteries.
- · Avoid spilling food or beverages on the toy.
- Do not throw or kick the toy, and do not push sharp objects through the speaker openings.
- Do not leave toy in direct sunlight: high temperatures will destroy the mechanism.

To Replace Batteries

- 1. Locate battery compartment on puppy's tummy.
- 2. Loosen screw on battery door.
- 3. Remove and discard old batteries.
- 4. Replace with fresh 3 x 1.5V "AAA" or LR03 size alkaline batteries.
- 5. Replace door and tighten screw. \bigcirc AAA \bigcirc AAA \bigcirc AAA \bigcirc AAA

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

CAUTION:

1. As with all small batteries, the batteries used with this toy should be kept away from small children who still put things in their mouths.
