

# Zambi the Baby Elephant

ZAMBI THE BABY ELEPHANT moves and makes sounds just like a real elephant! Be sure to take good care of your pet by following the instructions in this booklet.


Note to the consumer: This toy is packaged in "TRY ME" mode. When you bring the toy home, activate its full range of features by moving the toy's TRY ME/OFF/ON switch to the "ON" position.



Replace with 4 x 1.5V "AA" or LR6 size alkaline batteries. Phittps/cross heat screwdrives. (not included) needed to replace batteries.



### **GETTING TO KNOW ZAMBI**



#### **HOW TO PLAY**

To turn ZAMBI THE BABY ELEPHANT ON. open the plush flap over the battery door and switch the TRY ME/OFF/ON switch to ON. Then close the plush flap. Pet ZAMBI on his back to activate his sensors.

TRY ME OFF ON

ZAMBI responds to your touch and moves his trunk, ears, head and mouth just like a real elephant! He also trumpets, makes kissing and eating sounds, and giggles when you tickle him.

For ZAMBI to "blow" kisses at you, touch the underside or tip of his trunk while it's in the up position. He makes kissing sounds! To make 7AMBI move his trunk to the up position, press down on his back for several seconds.

For ZAMBI to curl his trunk around your finger, touch the underside of his trunk while it's in the down position.




















Pet ZAMBI on his back and he'll respond to your touch by wiggling his ears, moving his trunk or making trumpeting, sighing or eating sounds. If you press his back for several seconds, he'll raise his trunk and make "kissing" sounds!

Tickle ZAMBI on his chest to make him giggle. It's easiest to do this when ZAMBI is in a sitting position.

To get ZAMBI to sit, simply push his back legs down until he is in a sitting position. His head will adjust when he's sitting so he still looks forward.

If you stop playing with ZAMBI for about a minute, he will go into "daydream" mode and won't respond to your touch. To "wake" him up, press his back.





## NOTE 🔑

This toy uses battery power whenever its switch is in the "ON" position. To conserve batteries, move the switch to "OFF" when you're not playing with it.



#### NOTE

- If ZAMBI doesn't seem to be responding to you, try petting his back.
- If that doesn't work, or if ZAMBI starts to make erratic movements or sounds, the battery power may be low. Replace batteries.

#### CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

To clean your pet, gently brush his fur with a cloth or soft brush to loosen any dirt. Then use a slightly damp cloth to remove stains.

- Do not put in the washing machine.
- Do not submerge in water.
- · Do not use detergent or stain removers on fur.
- Do not get wet; to remove stains, use only a slightly damp cloth on the fur.
- To prevent staining fur, wipe off dirt immediately.
- . If toy gets wet, remove batteries and dry the fur: once fur is completely dry, replace batteries.
- Avoid spilling food or beverages on the toy.
- . Do not throw or kick the toy, and do not push sharp objects through the speaker openings.

 Do not leave toy in direct sunlight; high temperatures will destroy the mechanism.

## TO REPLACE BATTERIES

Open the plush flap over the battery compartment. Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screws in battery compartment cover (screws stay attached to cover). Remove cover. Remove and discard old batteries. Replace with fresh 4 x 1.5V "AA" or LR6 size alkaline batteries. Replace cover and tighten screws.

















# IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION



# **CAUTION:**

- Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.
- Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
