

Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) required to complete assembly.







#### **WARNING:**




**NOTE:** Check assembly by pressing the button on each arm and rotating each base until button pops out to display the word "LOCKED" and a snap is heard. If no snap is heard, go back and check assembly.

# ADJUST FOR TUMMY TIME: Lay toy down so bottom of electronic unit rests on floor. Press buttons and rotate bases down so they lie flat on floor. PRESS PRESS

**ADJUST TO GYM:** 

ay toy down so bottom of electronic unit rests on floor. Press buttons and rotate bases into 'up" position (listen for snap). Lift electronic unit to stand toy up.



**NOTE:** Be sure baby is clear of toy when adjusting leg positions.

## PLAY:

#### **MUSIC SETTINGS:**

Adjust switch on electronic unit to change the Music Settings.

Single Note – short play.

Multiple Notes – long play.

Center - music off.

Adjust sound to High or Low with the Volume switch.


**NOTE:** Music is also activated by pressing light-up characters.

**NOTE:** After a brief period of inactivity, toy will prompt baby to play again before shutting itself off.

#### WIGGLE SUN:

Pull down and release.





#### TO INSERT BATTERIES:

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screw in battery compartment door (screw remains attached to door). Remove door. Insert 3 x 1.5V "AA" or R6 size batteries.

Alkaline batteries recommended. Replace door and tighten screw.
