

1. REMOVE V-SIGHT AND TAKE OUT CABLE



2. ATTACH THE CRADLE TO BLASTER

Push cradle down until it clicks into place. Once attached it cannot be removed. Adult assembly required.


▲ CAUTION:




4. INSERT DEVICE INTO MATCHING SKIN

- iPhone 3GS does not require a skin.





5. CONNECT AND INSERT YOUR DEVICE






3. RELEASE LATCH AND OPEN CRADLE

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

▲ CAUTION:

1. TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and – polarity markings.
- b. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
