



Slide switch to OFF position when not in use to help conserve battery power.


## Chase-Me Play

Replace door and tighten screw.

## **Counting Fun**


Feed balls into the lion's mouth. The lion will count the balls up to 10. After 10 seconds of inactivity, the counter will reset to one. Pushing the tail down will also reset the counter.





#### **Language Button**

Press the language button to change languages. Press the button repeatedly until you hear the name of the language being announced in that language.



You can lock the language selection for continued counting in a particular language. Press the language button repeatedly, until you've selected the desired language. When you hear the desired language being announced, continue pressing the button for 5 seconds, or until you hear a locking sound effect. The sound will confirm that the language button is activated.

(PIGUET)



When the language selection is locked, pressing the language button will announce the current language followed by a locked sound effect. This will not change the language.

When you're ready to unlock the language selection, press the language button for 5 seconds, or until you hear 3 beeps followed by a locking sound effect. Release the button. The language button is now unlocked.

NOTE: If the toy is turned off, or if the toy loses power while in the locked mode, the language button will be unlocked when the toy is turned back on.
