

### TO INSTALL BATTERIES:





Using Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included), loosen screws in battery compartment cover (screws stay attached to cover). Remove cover. Insert 3 x 1.5V "AA" or R6 size batteries. Alkaline batteries recommended. Replace cover and tighten screws.






- 1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and polarity markings.
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- 6. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
- 7. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging.

  Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.




## ● TO CREATE LITE-BRITE® PICTURES:

Tear the pattern sheets along the perforated lines and remove.







Slide a pattern sheet from the top along the track keeping it flat and straight on the peg screen. Position the sheet so that the star on each corner is next to a corner on the peg screen. Push a peg through the hole in each star to secure the sheet to the screen.

When creating a picture, follow the printed letters on the sheet that tell which colored pegs to use (see chart below). If you are making a free-form picture, simply insert the pegs through the holes wherever you want for your own unique designs.

O = ORANGE RED

W = WHITE BLUE


= YELLOW V = VIOLET




Insert the colored pegs through the paper and into the peg screen as far as they will go.



Press the button to make your creation shine! Press the button a second time to make your creation blink. Press the button a third time to turn it off.
