

Note to Consumer:

This Mr. Potato Head® toy is packaged in try me mode. Whe you bring him home, activate his full range of features by moving the power switch (located on battery box) from "Try Me" to "On." Press hat and follow his prompts.



To Play!

To begin, make sure the On/Off switch is turned to On. Press his hat to begin. Your POPPING TALKING TATER will ask you which mode you'd like to play. When you hear the one you want, press his hat to go into that mode. If you want to go back to the main menu, just press his hat again.

Follow Along

MR. POTATO HEAD will play "Mr. Potato Head® Says" with you. He can recognize which parts you put into holes for eyes, nose, and mouth, and responds. His parts will pop out automatically.



Tater Timer™

He says, "Push my hat if you want to race the TATER TIMER." How fast can you put his parts in? Race to put all his parts in before the timer goes off. In this mode, his parts will pop out automatically.



Free Play

He says, "Let's play Pick a Part!" Place any piece into the front three holes on MR. POTATO HEAD and he will give you a silly response. In this mode, press his hat to make parts pop out.

Sleep Mode:

After a short time of non-play, this MR. POTATO HEAD toy will go into sleep mode. You can still put parts in while he is in sleep mode, but he won't respond until you wake him up by pressing his hat.

To put him into sleep mode, hold his hat for 5 seconds



Popping Feature:


After completing the Song Mode and TATER TIMER mode, MR. POTATO HEAD will wiggle his parts, turns, and automatically pop his parts out. Press his hat to make him pop his parts (without turning around) in Pick a Part mode, or during the middle any other mode.

Note: You can place any part anywhere on his body, but he recognizes and responds to parts placed in three front holes only.

Note: Regular MR. POTATO HEAD parts and pieces will not work in POPPING TALKING TATER.



Troubleshooting	
Wiggles and spins slowly	Replace batteries
Ends up off-center after spinning	Put him into sleep mode, then turn feet.
Doesn't pop parts	Automatically pop parts in TATER TIMER or Song Mode. Press his hat to make them pop in Pick a Part mode, or check the batteries.
Doesn't respond to inserted parts	Responds only to the front three holes.
Keeps falling asleep or Keeps switching modes	Holding hat for several seconds puts him into sleep mode. Try holding on to feet or other part of his body while inserting parts.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

CAUTION:

- 1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and polarity markings.
- Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
