



TO REPLACE BATTERIES

Using a Phillips/cross head screwdriver, loosen screw in battery compartment cover (screw stays attached to cover). Insert 3 x 1.5V "AA" or LR6 size alkaline batteries (not included). Replace cover and tighten screw.
