



1.5V AA or LR6 size

BATTERIES INCLUDED

Replace with 3 x 1.5V "AA" or LR6 size alkaline batteries. Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) needed to replace batteries.

Note to the consumer: This toy is packaged in TRY ME mode. To switch it to PLAY mode, move the ON/OFF/TRY ME switch to the ON position. Switch is located on pony's back.



TO PLAY

PRESS PINKIE PIE® PONY'S HAND.

She talks and moves her legs!

HELP HER WALK WITH YOU!

Adjust your pony doll's legs so that you can hold her up in standing position.


Press her hand to activate leg motion, and then hold her hands to walk with her!

TO REPLACE BATTERIES



Use a Philips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screw in battery compartment cover (screw remains attached to cover). Remove cover. Remove and discard old batteries. Replace with fresh 3 x 1.5V "AA" or LR6 size alkaline batteries. Replace cover and tighten screw.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

CAUTION:

- 1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and polarity markings.
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- 6. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
