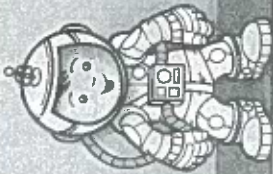

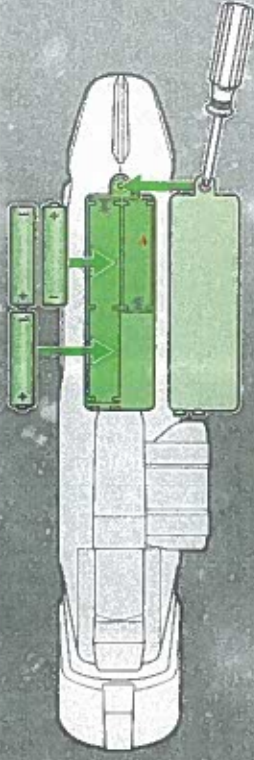

**TO INSERT BATTERIES:**  
PHILLIPS/CROSS HEAD SCREWDRIVER (NOT INCLUDED) NEEDED TO INSERT BATTERIES. LOOSEN SCREW IN BATTERY COMPARTMENT COVER (SCREW REMAINS ATTACHED TO COVER). REMOVE COVER. INSERT 3 X 1.5V AA ALKALINE BATTERIES (NOT INCLUDED). REPLACE COVER AND TIGHTEN SCREW.

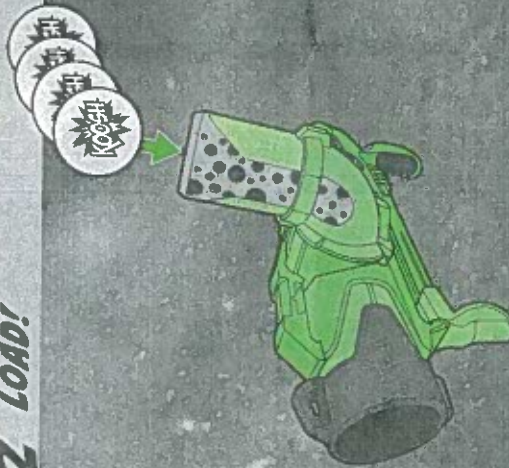

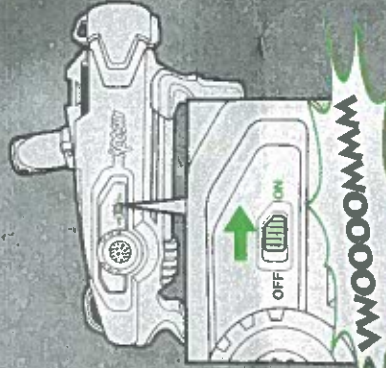

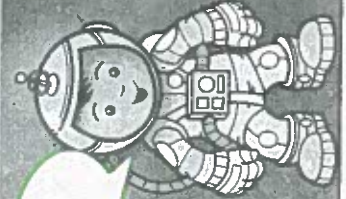

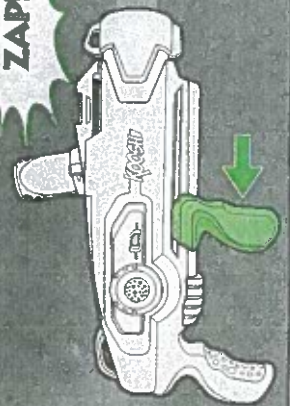

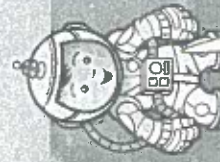
