

This toy is packaged in TRY ME mode. Slide the Power Switch to ON position for the full range of features.



Includes Elmo and 7 blocks. Blocks and base each contain one magnet.







Discovery Mode:

Place a block into Elmo's hands. Elmo will move his head to take a "look" at the block. Elmo will then identify the name of the letter on the block. He will also announce what sound the letter makes, a word (pictured on the block) that starts with that letter and a fun fact.



Question Mode:

Push the button on the front of the base to enter Question Mode. Elmo will ask you to find a letter or picture on one of the blocks. Once a block is selected, place it in Elmo's hands.

After 5 questions in a row are correctly answered, Elmo will revert to Discovery Mode. Press the button again to go back to Question Mode.

If 2 questions in a row are answered incorrectly, Elmo will revert to Discovery Mode. Practice learning more about letters in Discovery Mode before going back to Question Mode.



Encourage your child to point to each letter of the alphabet along Elmo's base, and sing the alphabet song together as he goes! Have him choose a Letter of the Day and then find that block. Talk about the sound that letter makes and the picture next to it. Go on a hunt to find something in the room that begins with the same letter.



Together with your child, learn even more about letters by encouraging her to find her favorite letter, a letter that starts with the name of an object or the first letter of her name! To explore further, help her to spell her whole name and simple words using the blocks. Ask her to say each letter as she goes!

Sleep Mode:

After a short period of inactivity, Elmo will enter sleep mode. Press the button or slide a block into Elmo's hands to keep playing. If Elmo is in Sleep Mode too long, he will turn off to conserve battery power. Switch the TRY ME/ON/OFF button OFF and then back to ON to reactivate.

Song blocks:

Elmo comes with 2 sound blocks. Place the ABC sound block in Elmo's hands and he'll sing The Alphabet Song. Place the block with Elmo and the music notes in Elmo's hands and he'll sing the Friendship Song.

TO REPLACE BATTERIES:

Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) to loosen screw in battery compartment cover (screw remains attached to cover). Remove cover. Remove and discard old batteries. Replace with fresh 4 x 1.5V "AA" or R6 size batteries. Alkaline batteries recommended. Replace cover and tighten screw.
